HOW TO FIND THE PERCENT OF A NUMBER

THE BASIC FORMULA

PRACTICAL APPLICATIONS OF FINDING PERCENTAGES

CALCULATING DISCOUNTS AND SALE PRICES

SUPPOSE AN ITEM COSTS \$1000 AND IS DISCOUNTED BY 10%. TO FIND THE DISCOUNT:

- CONVERT 10% TO DECIMAL: 0.10

- FIND INTEREST ON \$1000:

$$0.009 \times 1000 = \$9$$

- TOTAL AMOUNT AFTER ONE YEAR: $1000 + 9 = \$1009$

ANALYZING DATA AND STATISTICS

IF A SURVEY REPORTS THAT 0.9 OF THE PARTICIPANTS PREFER A CERTAIN BRAND, AND THERE ARE 1000 PARTICIPANTS:

- NUMBER OF PEOPLE: $0.9 \times 1000 = 900$

COMMON MISTAKES TO AVOID WHEN CALCULATING PERCENTAGES

CONFUSING DECIMAL AND PERCENTAGE FORMS

IF AN ORGANIZATION ALLOCATES 0.12 (12%) OF ITS BUDGET OF \$500,000 TO MARKETING:

- CONVERT 12% TO DECIMAL: 0.12
- MULTIPLY: $0.12 \times 500,000 = \$60,000$

THE MARKETING BUDGET AMOUNTS TO \$60,000.

UNDERSTANDING PERCENTAGES BEYOND THE BASICS

$$\left[\left(\frac{A}{B} \right) \times 100 \right]$$

EXAMPLE:

- A = 250
- B = 1000
- CALCULATION:

$$\left[\left(\frac{250}{1000} \right) \times 100 = 0.25 \times 100 = 25\% \right]$$

So, 250 is 25% of 1000.
