RECOGNIZING THESE GEOGRAPHICAL FACTORS OFFERS VALUABLE INSIGHTS INTO WHY NEW YORK REMAINS A LEADING CITY ON THE WORLD STAGE AND HOW ITS LOCATION WILL CONTINUE TO INFLUENCE ITS DEVELOPMENT IN THE DECADES TO COME.

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
