INTERDEPENDENCE OF DOMAINS

- EVIDENCE ILLUSTRATES THAT LEGAL, ECONOMIC, AND CULTURAL SYSTEMS DO NOT OPERATE IN ISOLATION BUT ARE MUTUALLY REINFORCING.

THESE VISUAL TOOLS HELP CLARIFY COMPLEX RELATIONSHIPS, MAKING IT EASIER TO GRASP THE MULTIFACETED CONNECTIONS AMONG EVIDENCE.

WHY THESE CONNECTIONS MATTER

UNDERSTANDING WHAT CONNECTIONS WILKERSON EXPLAINS AMONG THE EVIDENCE IS VITAL BECAUSE:

- IT REVEALS SYSTEMIC ROOTS OF SOCIETAL ISSUES, MOVING BEYOND SURFACE EXPLANATIONS.
- IT DEMONSTRATES HOW MULTIPLE FACTORS—HISTORY, LAW, ECONOMICS, CULTURE—INTERACT TO PRODUCE PERSISTENT INEQUALITIES.
- IT INFORMS EFFECTIVE SOLUTIONS THAT TARGET SYSTEMIC CHANGE RATHER THAN ISOLATED PROBLEMS.

CONCLUSION

WILKERSON'S EXPLORATION OF THE CONNECTIONS AMONG EVIDENCE UNDERSCORES HER HOLISTIC APPROACH TO UNDERSTANDING SOCIETAL ISSUES.
