- IT SYMBOLIZES THE BETRAYAL OF REVOLUTIONARY IDEALS AND THE CYCLICAL NATURE OF TYRANNY.
- ITS LONG-TERM EFFECTS INCLUDE INCREASED DEPENDENCE ON EXTERNAL POWERS, INTERNAL CORRUPTION, AND THE EVENTUAL DECLINE OF THE ORIGINAL REVOLUTION.
- ORWELL USES THIS EVENT TO CRITIQUE REAL-WORLD POLITICAL SYSTEMS AND HIGHLIGHT THE IMPORTANCE OF REMAINING VIGILANT AGAINST CORRUPTION AND EXTERNAL EXPLOITATION.

UNDERSTANDING THESE OUTCOMES ENRICHES OUR COMPREHENSION OF ANIMAL FARM AS A TIMELESS ALLEGORY AND A CAUTIONARY TALE ABOUT THE CORRUPTING INFLUENCE OF POWER AND THE COMPLEXITIES OF REVOLUTIONARY CHANGE.

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
