PHENYLEPHRINE OVERDOSE

HIGH DOSES OF PHENYLEPHRINE, A POTENT DECONGESTANT, CAN CAUSE HYPERTENSION, TACHYCARDIA, AND NERVOUSNESS. SEVERE OVERDOSE MAY LEAD TO ARRHYTHMIAS OR STROKE.

WHAT TO DO IN CASE OF OVERDOSE

ADDITIONALLY, THERE ARE INACTIVE INGREDIENTS LIKE DYES, FLAVORING AGENTS, AND PRESERVATIVES, WHICH GENERALLY DO NOT POSE HEALTH RISKS AT STANDARD DOSES.

INTENDED DOSE: TYPICALLY, A STANDARD ADULT DOSE IS 2 TABLESPOONS (30 ML) EVERY 4 HOURS, NOT EXCEEDING 6 DOSES IN 24 HOURS.

THE HYPOTHETICAL: CONSUMING AN ENTIRE BOTTLE OF DAYQUIL

SUPPOSE AN INDIVIDUAL CONSUMES AN ENTIRE BOTTLE—SAY, 8 OZ (240 ML)—OF DAYQUIL. THIS IS SIGNIFICANTLY MORE THAN THE RECOMMENDED DOSE, AND SUCH AN ACTION IS CONSIDERED AN OVERDOSE.

CALCULATING THE TOTAL INTAKE

- ACETAMINOPHEN:
- 1 TABLESPOON (15 ML) CONTAINS APPROXIMATELY 162.5 MG.
- 8 OZ (240 ML) IS 16 TABLESPOONS.
- TOTAL ACETAMINOPHEN = $16 \times 162.5 \text{ MG} \approx 2,600 \text{ MG}$.
- DEXTROMETHORPHAN:
- 1 TABLESPOON CONTAINS ROUGHLY 33-66 MG (DEPENDING ON FORMULATION).
- TOTAL DEXTROMETHORPHAN $\approx 528\text{-}1,056 \text{ MG}$.
- PHENYLEPHRINE:
- 1 TABLESPOON CONTAINS ABOUT 160 MG.
- TOTAL PHENYLEPHRINE $\approx 2,560 \text{ MG}$.

POTENTIAL IMMEDIATE EFFECTS OF OVERDOSE

CONSUMING A LARGE QUANTITY OF DAYQUIL CAN CAUSE A RANGE OF ADVERSE EFFECTS, MANY OF WHICH DEPEND ON THE AMOUNT INGESTED, THE INDIVIDUAL'S HEALTH STATUS, AGE, AND OTHER FACTORS.

EFFECTS OF EXCESS ACETAMINOPHEN

ACETAMINOPHEN OVERDOSE IS ONE OF THE MOST DANGEROUS ASPECTS OF CONSUMING TOO MUCH DAYQUIL.

- LIVER TOXICITY: THE LIVER METABOLIZES ACETAMINOPHEN, BUT AN OVERDOSE CAN OVERWHELM THIS PROCESS, LEADING TO ACUTE LIVER FAILURE.

 - EUPHORIA OR DYSPHORIA
 - ALTERED PERCEPTION
- PHYSICAL SYMPTOMS:

 - ELEVATED BLOOD PRESSURE
 - LOSS OF COORDINATION
- SERIOUS RISKS:

EFFECTS OF EXCESS PHENYLEPHRINE

PHENYLEPHRINE OVERDOSE CAN CAUSE SIGNIFICANT CARDIOVASCULAR ISSUES.

- SYMPATHETIC OVERDRIVE:
 - ELEVATED BLOOD PRESSURE (HYPERTENSION)
 - RAPID HEART RATE (TACHYCARDIA)
 - HEART PALPITATIONS
- OTHER SYMPTOMS:
 - HEADACHE
 - ANXIETY
 - TREMORS
 - POTENTIAL FOR ARRHYTHMIAS

SERIOUS RISKS AND MEDICAL EMERGENCIES

GIVEN THE COMBINED EFFECTS OF THESE INGREDIENTS, DRINKING AN ENTIRE BOTTLE OF DAYQUIL CAN RAPIDLY BECOME A LIFE-THREATENING SITUATION.

LIVER FAILURE

THE MOST DANGEROUS RISK IS ACUTE LIVER FAILURE DUE TO ACETAMINOPHEN OVERDOSE. WITHOUT PROMPT TREATMENT, THIS CAN LEAD TO:

- BLEEDING DISORDERS
- ENCEPHALOPATHY (BRAIN DYSFUNCTION)
- MULTI-ORGAN FAILURE
- DEATH

NEUROPSYCHIATRIC EFFECTS

HIGH DOSES OF DEXTROMETHORPHAN MAY INDUCE HALLUCINATIONS, PSYCHOSIS, OR AGITATION, WHICH CAN BE DANGEROUS, ESPECIALLY IN UNSUPERVISED SETTINGS.

CARDIOVASCULAR COLLAPSE

EXCESS PHENYLEPHRINE CAN CAUSE HYPERTENSIVE CRISIS, WHICH, IF SEVERE, MAY RESULT IN:

- STROKE
- HEART ATTACK
- ORGAN DAMAGE

OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

- RISK OF ASPIRATION: NAUSEA AND VOMITING MAY LEAD TO ASPIRATION, ESPECIALLY IF THE PERSON BECOMES UNCONSCIOUS.

- DEXTROMETHORPHAN OVERDOSE:

- BLOOD PRESSURE MANAGEMENT, SEDATION, AND CARDIAC MONITORING.

THE BEST WAY TO AVOID ADVERSE EFFECTS FROM DAYQUIL IS RESPONSIBLE USE.

WITH PROMPT INTERVENTION, MANY OF THE SEVERE EFFECTS CAN BE MITIGATED, BUT PREVENTION REMAINS THE BEST STRATEGY—USE MEDICATIONS RESPONSIBLY, FOLLOW DOSING INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY, AND SEEK HELP IF YOU SUSPECT AN OVERDOSE.

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
