THEY CULTIVATE NOT JUST KNOWLEDGE, BUT ALSO FOUNDATIONAL SKILLS LIKE ANALYSIS, ORGANIZATION, AND SELF-ASSESSMENT—SKILLS ESSENTIAL FOR LIFELONG LEARNING. AS TECHNOLOGY ADVANCES, THE POSSIBILITIES FOR ENHANCING DRAG-AND-DROP CONCEPT MAP ACTIVITIES ARE VIRTUALLY LIMITLESS, PROMISING AN EXCITING FUTURE FOR EDUCATIONAL INNOVATION.

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
