THE PHRASE "NEED HELP BAD. 40 POINT MAJOR HAVE NO IDEA DID NOT GET TAUGHT THIS" ENCAPSULATES A CRITICAL CHALLENGE FACING THE COMPETITIVE DOG COMMUNITY: THE NEED TO PRIORITIZE FOUNDATIONAL KNOWLEDGE AND SKILL MASTERY OVER SUPERFICIAL ACHIEVEMENTS. WHILE A MAJOR POINTS TALLY SIGNIFIES ACCOMPLISHMENT, TRUE EXCELLENCE IN CANINE COMPETITION HINGES ON A COMPREHENSIVE UNDERSTANDING OF TRAINING, BEHAVIOR, AND ETHICS. AS THE SPORT EVOLVES, FOSTERING A CULTURE OF CONTINUOUS LEARNING, INTEGRITY, AND RESPECT FOR THE ANIMALS WILL ENSURE THAT SUCCESS IS MEANINGFUL, SUSTAINABLE, AND BENEFICIAL FOR ALL INVOLVED. ONLY THROUGH EMBRACING THESE PRINCIPLES CAN THE COMMUNITY ELEVATE ITS STANDARDS AND ENSURE THE LONG-TERM HEALTH AND VITALITY OF THE SPORT.

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
