VARIATIONS AND SIMILAR PHRASES

EXAMPLE:

> "THIS APPROACH RELIES ON CONSISTENT EFFORT OVER TIME. THAT'S RIGHT."

HERE, THE PHRASE CONFIRMS THE READER'S COMPREHENSION AND SUBTLY AFFIRMS THE VALIDITY OF THE APPROACH DISCUSSED.

3. CREATING A CONVERSATIONAL AND ENGAGING TONE

PRACTICAL IMPLICATIONS FOR WRITERS AND SPEAKERS

HOW TO USE "THAT'S RIGHT" EFFECTIVELY

COMMON CONTEXTS WHERE “THAT’S RIGHT” IS MOST EFFECTIVE

1. EDUCATIONAL CONTENT

TO CONFIRM UNDERSTANDING AND REINFORCE LEARNING POINTS.

2. PERSUASIVE WRITING
