BY WEAVING THESE PURPOSES TOGETHER, TAPPLY CREATES A LAYERED NARRATIVE THAT INVITES READERS TO REFLECT ON PERSONAL AND SOCIETAL ISSUES WHILE BEING THOROUGHLY ENGAGED IN A CAPTIVATING STORY.

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#### FINAL THOUGHTS

UNDERSTANDING THE AUTHOR'S PURPOSE IN "THE BALTIMORE HOUSE" ENRICHES THE READER'S APPRECIATION OF THE STORY'S DEPTH AND COMPLEXITY. RECOGNIZING THAT TAPPLY'S WORK IS NOT MERELY ABOUT PLOT BUT ALSO ABOUT CONVEYING PROFOUND MESSAGES ABOUT MORALITY, COMMUNITY, AND IDENTITY ALLOWS READERS TO EXPERIENCE THE STORY ON A DEEPER LEVEL. WHETHER IT'S TO ENTERTAIN, CRITIQUE, OR EXPLORE HUMAN NATURE, TAPPLY'S STORYTELLING CONTINUES TO RESONATE, ILLUSTRATING THE ENDURING POWER OF THOUGHTFULLY CRAFTED LITERATURE.
