AS PRESSURES FROM URBANIZATION, CLIMATE CHANGE, AND ENVIRONMENTAL CHALLENGES GROW, CONTINUED EFFORTS TO PRESERVE AND ENHANCE THE THAMES'S HEALTH AND VITALITY REMAIN VITAL FOR FUTURE GENERATIONS. WHETHER VIEWED THROUGH THE LENS OF HISTORY, ECOLOGY, OR URBAN PLANNING, THE THAMES REMAINS A CENTRAL ARTERY OF SOUTHEASTERN GREAT BRITAIN, CONNECTING LAND, WATER, AND PEOPLE IN A COMPLEX AND DYNAMIC RELATIONSHIP.

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
