SIMILARLY, THE ANALOGY WE'RE FOCUSING ON INVOLVES UNDERSTANDING THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE GIVEN WORDS AND FINDING APPROPRIATE COUNTERPARTS TO COMPLETE THE ANALOGY.

BREAKING DOWN THE GIVEN ANALOGY

THE ANALOGY IN QUESTION IS:

PRECARIOUS : SUBSISTENCE :: VORACIOUS : ABYSMAL :: WOOD : TO

LET'S ANALYZE EACH PART:

1. PRECARIOUS : SUBSISTENCE

WOOD (RAW MATERIAL) IS TO BUILD (TO CONSTRUCT) AS THE OBJECT OR MATERIAL USED FOR CREATING STRUCTURES.

- PRACTICE WITH VARIOUS EXAMPLES TO IMPROVE REASONING SKILLS.

POSSIBLE COMPLETION: "ABYSMAL"

WHILE "ABYSMAL" PRIMARILY DESCRIBES POOR QUALITY, IT CAN ALSO DESCRIBE A SITUATION OR CONDITION. FOR INSTANCE, "ABYSMAL SUBSISTENCE" WOULD MEAN VERY POOR OR TERRIBLE SURVIVAL CONDITIONS.

- "ABYSMAL" AS AN ADJECTIVE CAN APPROPRIATELY DESCRIBE THE QUALITY OF "SUBSISTENCE" IN AN ANALOGY, SIMILAR TO HOW "PRECARIOUS" DESCRIBES ITS CONDITION.

- THEREFORE, THE ANALOGY COULD BE INTERPRETED AS:

"PRECARIOUS" (UNSTABLE) RELATES TO "SUBSISTENCE" (SURVIVAL NEEDS) AS "VORACIOUS" (INSATIABLE APPETITE) RELATES TO "ABYSMAL" (POOR QUALITY OR STATE).

- "PRECARIOUS" IS TO "SUBSISTENCE" (UNSTABLE SURVIVAL) AS "VORACIOUS" IS TO "APPETITE" OR "HUNGER".

BUT SINCE "APPETITE" OR "HUNGER" ISN'T LISTED, PERHAPS THE OPTIONS ARE MORE CONCEPTUAL.

CONCLUSION: COMPLETING THE ANALOGY

BASED ON THE ANALYSIS:

FINAL THOUGHTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS FOR COMPLETING ANALOGIES

- UNDERSTAND THE CORE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE FIRST PAIR: IN THIS CASE, AN ADJECTIVE DESCRIBING THE QUALITY OR CONDITION OF A NOUN.
