THESE DOCUMENTS ARE VITAL FOR:

- MAINTAINING LEGAL COMPLIANCE
- SUPPORTING ONGOING PROJECTS
- MANAGING EMPLOYEE AND CLIENT RELATIONSHIPS
- ENSURING ACCURATE FINANCIAL REPORTING

- SECURED THE SITE TO PREVENT FURTHER DAMAGE

- INITIATED INTERNAL INVESTIGATION TO ASSESS THE EXTENT OF DATA LOSS

DATA RECOVERY EFFORTS

THE COMPANY'S IT AND RECORDS MANAGEMENT TEAMS BEGAN EFFORTS TO:

- RETRIEVE BACKUPS STORED OFFSITE OR IN CLOUD-BASED SYSTEMS

REVIEW OF SECURITY AND BACKUP PROTOCOLS

IN THE AFTERMATH, CONRAD, INC. EVALUATED AND ENHANCED ITS DATA SECURITY MEASURES:

- ENSURE ELECTRICAL SYSTEMS ARE INSPECTED AND MAINTAINED

EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLANNING

ACCORDING TO INITIAL REPORTS FROM EMERGENCY RESPONDERS, THE FIRE WAS LOCALIZED PRIMARILY WITHIN THE ADMINISTRATIVE AND RECORDS STORAGE AREAS. THE FIRE DEPARTMENT RESPONDED PROMPTLY, CONTAINING THE BLAZE WITHIN A FEW HOURS, BUT NOT BEFORE SUBSTANTIAL DAMAGE WAS INFLICTED.

KEY FACTS ABOUT THE INCIDENT INCLUDE:

- TIME AND DATE: THE FIRE WAS REPORTED AT APPROXIMATELY 9:15 AM ON OCTOBER 22, 2023.

THE LOSS OF PHYSICAL RECORDS DISRUPTED ONGOING PROJECTS, CLIENT DOCUMENTATION, AND INTERNAL ADMINISTRATIVE FUNCTIONS. THE COMPANY'S EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM, IN COORDINATION WITH LOCAL AUTHORITIES, ACTIVATED ITS DISASTER RECOVERY PROTOCOLS, INCLUDING BACKUP DATA RETRIEVAL AND COMMUNICATION WITH STAKEHOLDERS.

FURTHERMORE, THE INCIDENT PROMPTED A TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THE OFFICE PREMISES, WITH EMPLOYEES WORKING REMOTELY OR FROM ALTERNATIVE LOCATIONS. THE INCIDENT ALSO TRIGGERED AN INTERNAL REVIEW OF SAFETY MEASURES AND FIRE PREVENTION STRATEGIES.

SCOPE AND NATURE OF THE LOST RECORDS

CATEGORIES OF LOST DATA

THE RECORDS LOST IN THE FIRE ENCOMPASSED A BROAD SPECTRUM OF CRITICAL INFORMATION, VITAL FOR THE COMPANY'S DAY-TO-DAY FUNCTIONS AND LONG-TERM STRATEGIC PLANNING. THESE INCLUDED:

- FINANCIAL DOCUMENTS: AUDITED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS, TAX RECORDS, PAYROLL DATA, AND BANKING CORRESPONDENCE.
- LEGAL AND COMPLIANCE RECORDS: CONTRACTS, LICENSING AGREEMENTS, INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY DOCUMENTATION, AND COMPLIANCE REPORTS.

PHYSICAL VS. DIGITAL DATA LOSS

WHILE SOME DATA WAS STORED DIGITALLY ON SERVERS AND CLOUD PLATFORMS, A SUBSTANTIAL PORTION WAS HOUSED IN PHYSICAL FORMATS — PAPER FILES, BINDERS, AND ARCHIVED DOCUMENTS. THE FIRE PRIMARILY AFFECTED THESE PHYSICAL RECORDS, ALTHOUGH SOME DIGITAL BACKUPS WERE ALSO COMPROMISED DUE TO POWER OUTAGES AND WATER DAMAGE.

THE DUAL NATURE OF DATA STORAGE AT CONRAD, INC. — COMBINING PHYSICAL AND DIGITAL FORMATS — HIGHLIGHTS BOTH VULNERABILITIES AND THE IMPORTANCE OF COMPREHENSIVE DATA MANAGEMENT STRATEGIES.

IMPLICATIONS OF THE RECORD LOSS

OPERATIONAL DISRUPTIONS

- INSUFFICIENT PHYSICAL SAFEGUARDS FOR VALUABLE DOCUMENTS.
