BASIC CONVERSION FORMULA

$$[D = d \times 25 \text{ \text{MILES} }]$$

WHERE:

- D IS THE DISTANCE IN INCHES ON THE MAP
- $\bar{D}$ IS THE ACTUAL DISTANCE IN MILES

$$\bar{D} = 3 \times 25 = 75 \text{ MILES}$$

UNDERSTANDING MAP MEASUREMENTS

FOR MORE PRECISE PLANNING, JAN WILL NEED TO:
