UNDERSTANDING THESE FACTORS UNDERSCORES WHY COUPLES LIKE SANTIAGO AND MARY PRIORITIZE EMOTIONAL COMPATIBILITY.

CONCLUSION: THE ENDURING POWER OF LOVE AND CONNECTION

THE DESIRE TO MARRY AMONG AMERICANS—EXEMPLIFIED BY SANTIAGO AND MARY—IS FUNDAMENTALLY ABOUT SEEKING A PROFOUND EMOTIONAL CONNECTION AND COMPANIONSHIP. WHILE LEGAL, FINANCIAL, AND SOCIETAL FACTORS ALSO PLAY ROLES, LOVE REMAINS THE CORE MOTIVATOR THAT DRIVES INDIVIDUALS TO FORMALIZE THEIR RELATIONSHIPS THROUGH MARRIAGE.

THIS EMPHASIS ON EMOTIONAL FULFILLMENT REFLECTS BROADER CULTURAL VALUES: THE PURSUIT OF HAPPINESS, PERSONAL GROWTH, AND MEANINGFUL RELATIONSHIPS. FOR SANTIAGO AND MARY, THEIR JOURNEY TOWARD MARRIAGE IS NOT JUST ABOUT LEGAL RECOGNITION BUT ABOUT AFFIRMING THEIR BOND, SHARING THEIR LIVES, AND BUILDING A FUTURE GROUNDED IN LOVE AND MUTUAL SUPPORT. THEIR STORY ENCAPSULATES THE TIMELESS HUMAN ASPIRATION TO FIND COMPANIONSHIP, HIGHLIGHTING WHY MARRIAGE CONTINUES TO BE A VITAL INSTITUTION IN AMERICAN SOCIETY.

IN SUMMARY, THE MOST COMMON REASON AMERICANS WANT TO GET MARRIED IS TO FULFILL THEIR NEED FOR EMOTIONAL CONNECTION AND COMPANIONSHIP—A TESTAMENT TO THE ENDURING POWER OF LOVE AS THE FOUNDATION OF HUMAN RELATIONSHIPS. SANTIAGO AND MARY'S DECISION EXEMPLIFIES THIS UNIVERSAL PURSUIT, ILLUSTRATING THAT AT THE HEART OF MARRIAGE LIES A SIMPLE YET PROFOUND DESIRE: TO SHARE LIFE WITH SOMEONE SPECIAL.

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
