- SHE WAS MARRIED TO KING PRASUTAGUS, A CLIENT KING ALLIED WITH ROME.
- FOLLOWING PRASUTAGUS'S DEATH AROUND AD 60-61, THE ROMANS SEIZED HIS ESTATE AND MISTREATED BOADICEA AND HER DAUGHTERS, FUELING HER DESIRE FOR REVENGE.

THE CATALYST FOR REBELLION

- THE IMMEDIATE CAUSE WAS ROMAN MISTREATMENT, INCLUDING:
- THE CONFISCATION OF ICENI LANDS.
- THE ASSAULT AND HUMILIATION OF BOADICEA'S FAMILY.
- THE BRUTAL SUPPRESSION OF ICENI AND OTHER TRIBES' PROTESTS.
- BOADICEA'S OUTRAGE TRANSFORMED HER FROM A TRIBAL LEADER INTO A SYMBOL OF RESISTANCE.
