THE DESIGN AND STRUCTURE OF THE STEP PYRAMID

- COMPLEX UNDERGROUND GALLERIES AND DRAINAGE SYSTEMS PROTECTED THE TOMB FROM FLOODING AND DECAY.

RELIGIOUS AND SYMBOLIC SIGNIFICANCE

THE DESIGN AND ORIENTATION OF THE STEP PYRAMID WERE IMBUED WITH DEEP RELIGIOUS SYMBOLISM.

COSMOLOGICAL SIGNIFICANCE
