Implications of Excluding Price from Performance Descriptions

The absence of price information in performance evaluations can have both positive and negative consequences for consumers.

Advantages

- GUIDE CONSUMER EXPECTATIONS: HELP BUYERS UNDERSTAND WHAT THEY ARE GETTING AND WHAT THEY MIGHT MISS.
- ESTABLISH TRANSPARENCY: SHOW THAT THE REVIEW IS COMPREHENSIVE BUT HONEST ABOUT WHAT IS NOT INCLUDED.

WHAT IS USUALLY LEFT OUT? THE "EXCEPT" FACTOR

WHILE REVIEWS AIM TO BE COMPREHENSIVE, THEY OFTEN OMIT CERTAIN ASPECTS INTENTIONALLY OR UNINTENTIONALLY. THE PHRASE "EXCEPT _____" SIGNALS THAT ONE PARTICULAR AREA IS NOT DISCUSSED OR IS EXCLUDED. COMMON AREAS THAT MIGHT BE LEFT OUT INCLUDE:

1. PRICE OF THE PRODUCT

- COST IS OFTEN CONSIDERED SEPARATELY FROM PERFORMANCE.

ANALYZING THE IMPLICATION OF OMISSION

- HIGHLIGHTS DRIVING EXPERIENCE BUT LEAVES OUT LONG-TERM OWNERSHIP EXPENSES.

EXAMPLE 3: SOFTWARE EVALUATION

"THE PERFORMANCE REVIEW MENTIONS RESPONSIVENESS, STABILITY, AND USABILITY, EXCEPT CUSTOMER SUPPORT."

- INDICATES THE SOFTWARE IS TECHNICALLY SOUND BUT MAY HAVE ISSUES WITH POST-SALE ASSISTANCE.
