## UNDERSTANDING THE NARROW AND EXPANDED DEFINITIONS OF TERRORISM

EXAMPLES OF NARROW DEFINITIONS:

- THE U.S. FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION (FBI) DEFINES TERRORISM AS "THE UNLAWFUL USE OF FORCE OR VIOLENCE AGAINST PERSONS OR PROPERTY TO INTIMIDATE OR COERCE A GOVERNMENT, THE CIVILIAN POPULATION, OR ANY SEGMENT THEREOF, IN FURTHERANCE OF POLITICAL OR SOCIAL OBJECTIVES."
- THE UNITED NATIONS' DEFINITIONS TEND TO BE MORE CAUTIOUS, EMPHASIZING THE UNLAWFUL NATURE OF ACTS AND THEIR POLITICAL MOTIVATION.

LIMITATIONS OF THE NARROW DEFINITION:

- IT OFTEN EXCLUDES ACTS OF STATE TERRORISM OR ACTS COMMITTED BY GOVERNMENTS.
- IT MAY OVERLOOK ACTS MOTIVATED BY ECONOMIC, ENVIRONMENTAL, OR OTHER NON-POLITICAL REASONS.
- IT CAN BE OVERLY RESTRICTIVE, LIMITING THE SCOPE OF WHAT IS CONSIDERED TERRORISM.

### WHAT IS THE EXPANDED DEFINITION OF TERRORISM?

THE EXPANDED OR BROADER DEFINITION OF TERRORISM ENCOMPASSES A WIDER RANGE OF ACTS, MOTIVATIONS, AND ACTORS. IT RECOGNIZES THAT TERRORISM IS NOT LIMITED SOLELY TO POLITICALLY MOTIVATED VIOLENCE BUT CAN INCLUDE ACTS DRIVEN BY OTHER MOTIVES, INCLUDING ECONOMIC GAIN, SOCIAL UNREST, OR EVEN MISTAKEN/TARGETED VIOLENCE.

FEATURES OF THE EXPANDED DEFINITION INCLUDE:

- **BROADER RANGE OF ACTORS:** INCLUDES NON-STATE ACTORS, STATE-SPONSORED ENTITIES, AND INDIVIDUALS.
- **DIVERSE MOTIVATIONS:** BEYOND POLITICAL OR IDEOLOGICAL MOTIVES, IT CAN INCLUDE RELIGIOUS, ECONOMIC, OR SOCIAL FACTORS.
- **VARIETY OF ACTS:** ENCOMPASSES CYBERTERRORISM, BIOLOGICAL TERRORISM, AND OTHER UNCONVENTIONAL FORMS OF VIOLENCE.
- **LEGAL AND POLICY FLEXIBILITY:** ALLOWS FOR A MORE COMPREHENSIVE APPROACH TO COUNTERING VARIOUS FORMS OF VIOLENCE.

EXAMPLES OF EXPANDED DEFINITIONS:

- THE EUROPEAN UNION'S FRAMEWORK DECISION ON COMBATING TERRORISM BROADENS THE SCOPE TO INCLUDE ACTS INTENDED TO "SERIOUSLY INTIMIDATE A POPULATION, OR UNDULY COMPEL A GOVERNMENT OR INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION TO PERFORM OR ABSTAIN FROM PERFORMING ANY ACT."
- SOME SCHOLARS DEFINE TERRORISM AS "ANY ACT OF VIOLENCE THAT CAUSES FEAR OR INTIMIDATION AND IS MOTIVATED BY IDEOLOGICAL, POLITICAL, OR SOCIAL AIMS," REGARDLESS OF THE LEGALITY OR THE ACTOR'S IDENTITY.

ADVANTAGES OF THE EXPANDED DEFINITION:

- IT CAPTURES A WIDER ARRAY OF THREATS, INCLUDING NEWER FORMS OF TERRORISM LIKE CYBERTERRORISM.
- IT PROVIDES A MORE INCLUSIVE FRAMEWORK FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT AND INTELLIGENCE AGENCIES.
- IT RECOGNIZES THE EVOLVING NATURE OF TERRORISM IN THE MODERN WORLD.

## KEY DIFFERENCES BETWEEN NARROW AND EXPANDED DEFINITIONS OF TERRORISM

### SCOPE AND INCLUSIVENESS

- **NARROW DEFINITION:** FOCUSES ON SPECIFIC ACTS THAT ARE UNLAWFUL, POLITICALLY MOTIVATED, AND TARGETED AT CIVILIANS.

## TYPES OF ACTS COVERED

- NARROW DEFINITION: TYPICALLY LIMITED TO BOMBINGS, SHOOTINGS, HIJACKINGS, AND HOSTAGE-TAKING.
- EXPANDED DEFINITION: INCLUDES CYBERATTACKS, BIOLOGICAL ATTACKS, AND OTHER UNCONVENTIONAL METHODS.

## HUMAN RIGHTS AND CIVIL LIBERTIES

- OVERLY BROAD DEFINITIONS CAN LEAD TO THE CRIMINALIZATION OF LEGITIMATE PROTESTS OR POLITICAL DISSENT.
- CLEAR, NARROW DEFINITIONS HELP SAFEGUARD CIVIL LIBERTIES WHILE ADDRESSING GENUINE THREATS.

## INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

## CHALLENGES IN DEFINING TERRORISM

RECOGNIZING THE MAIN DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THESE DEFINITIONS IS ESSENTIAL FOR DEVELOPING COMPREHENSIVE STRATEGIES THAT ADAPT TO THE EVOLVING LANDSCAPE OF GLOBAL SECURITY THREATS.

### HOW DOES THE EXPANDED DEFINITION OF TERRORISM IMPACT INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION?

A BROADER DEFINITION FACILITATES BETTER INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION BY ENCOMPASSING A WIDER RANGE OF ACTIVITIES AND ACTORS, ENABLING COUNTRIES TO COLLABORATE MORE EFFECTIVELY IN INTELLIGENCE SHARING, LAW ENFORCEMENT, AND COUNTER-TERRORISM EFFORTS ACROSS DIFFERENT CONTEXTS.

### IN WHAT WAY DO THE MAIN DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THE DEFINITIONS INFLUENCE LEGAL PROCEEDINGS?

THE NARROW DEFINITION MAY LIMIT PROSECUTIONS TO SPECIFIC ACTS MEETING STRICT CRITERIA, WHILE THE EXPANDED DEFINITION ALLOWS FOR BROADER INTERPRETATIONS, POTENTIALLY LEADING TO MORE CASES BEING CLASSIFIED AS TERRORISM, BUT ALSO RAISING CONCERNS ABOUT OVERREACH AND CIVIL LIBERTIES.

## WHY DO SOME EXPERTS ADVOCATE FOR A NARROW DEFINITION OF TERRORISM?

EXPERTS FAVOR A NARROW DEFINITION TO MAINTAIN CLARITY, PREVENT MISUSE OF ANTI-TERROR LAWS, AND PROTECT CIVIL LIBERTIES BY ENSURING ONLY GENUINELY MALICIOUS ACTS ARE PROSECUTED UNDER TERRORISM STATUTES.

## HOW DO SOCIETAL PERCEPTIONS OF TERRORISM CHANGE BASED ON THE DEFINITION USED?

A NARROW DEFINITION MAY FOCUS PUBLIC CONCERN ON EXTREME, POLITICALLY MOTIVATED VIOLENCE, WHILE AN EXPANDED DEFINITION CAN INCREASE AWARENESS OF A WIDER RANGE OF THREATS, INFLUENCING PUBLIC PERCEPTION, POLICY PRIORITIES, AND RESOURCE ALLOCATION TOWARD COUNTER-TERRORISM.

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## DEFINING THE NARROW AND EXPANDED FRAMEWORKS OF TERRORISM

### THE NARROW DEFINITION OF TERRORISM

THE NARROW DEFINITION OF TERRORISM TENDS TO BE SPECIFIC, PRECISE, AND LIMITED IN SCOPE. IT GENERALLY EMPHASIZES CERTAIN CHARACTERISTICS THAT QUALIFY AN ACT AS TERRORISM, OFTEN ROOTED IN LEGAL, POLITICAL, OR SECURITY CONSIDERATIONS.

KEY CHARACTERISTICS:

- TARGETED VIOLENCE AGAINST CIVILIANS: ACTS TYPICALLY INVOLVE INTENTIONAL VIOLENCE DIRECTED SPECIFICALLY AT NON-COMBATANT CIVILIANS, OFTEN TO INDUCE FEAR OR COERCE SOCIETAL OR GOVERNMENTAL CHANGE.
- POLITICAL OR IDEOLOGICAL MOTIVATION: THE MOTIVATION BEHIND SUCH ACTS IS USUALLY TIED TO POLITICAL, RELIGIOUS, OR IDEOLOGICAL OBJECTIVES.
- USE OF UNLAWFUL MEANS: THE METHODS EMPLOYED ARE OFTEN ILLEGAL, SUCH AS BOMBINGS, ASSASSINATIONS, KIDNAPPINGS, OR HIJACKINGS.
- PRE-DEFINED ACTOR PROFILE: OFTEN, THE ACTORS INVOLVED ARE NON-STATE ACTORS OR INSURGENT GROUPS, ALTHOUGH SOME DEFINITIONS INCLUDE STATE-SPONSORED TERRORISM UNDER SPECIFIC CONDITIONS.
- LEGAL SPECIFICITY: MANY JURISDICTIONS ADOPT THE NARROW DEFINITION IN LAW, SPECIFYING CLEAR CRITERIA THAT MUST BE MET FOR AN ACT TO QUALIFY AS TERRORISM, THUS FACILITATING PROSECUTION.

EXAMPLE OF NARROW DEFINITION IN PRACTICE:

- THE UNITED STATES CODE (18 U.S. CODE § 2331) DEFINES TERRORISM AS "PREMEDITATED, POLITICALLY MOTIVATED VIOLENCE PERPETRATED AGAINST NON-COMBATANT TARGETS BY SUBNATIONAL GROUPS OR CLANDESTINE AGENTS."

THIS DEFINITION EMPHASIZES INTENTIONALITY, POLITICAL MOTIVATION, AND NON-COMBATANT TARGETS, MAKING IT QUITE SPECIFIC.

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## THE EXPANDED DEFINITION OF TERRORISM

IN CONTRAST, THE EXPANDED DEFINITION ADOPTS A BROADER, MORE INCLUSIVE PERSPECTIVE, CONSIDERING A WIDER RANGE OF ACTS, MOTIVATIONS, AND ACTORS. IT RECOGNIZES THE COMPLEXITIES AND NUANCES OF WHAT CONSTITUTES TERRORISM.

KEY CHARACTERISTICS:

- INCLUSION OF STATE AND NON-STATE ACTORS: THE EXPANDED VIEW OFTEN RECOGNIZES STATE-SPONSORED TERRORISM OR ACTS COMMITTED BY GOVERNMENT FORCES AS TERRORISM, BROADENING THE SCOPE BEYOND NON-STATE GROUPS.
- BROADER RANGE OF TARGETS: IT MAY INCLUDE VIOLENCE AGAINST MILITARY TARGETS, ECONOMIC INFRASTRUCTURE, SYMBOLIC SITES, OR EVEN ACTS THAT CAUSE SOCIETAL DISRUPTION, NOT JUST VIOLENCE AGAINST CIVILIANS.
- DIVERSE MOTIVATIONS: WHILE POLITICAL AND IDEOLOGICAL MOTIVES ARE CENTRAL, THE EXPANDED VIEW MAY ALSO ENCOMPASS ACTS MOTIVATED BY ECONOMIC GAIN (E.G., CYBERTERRORISM FOR FINANCIAL THEFT) OR OTHER NON-POLITICAL REASONS.
- METHODS AND MEANS: THE EXPANDED DEFINITION MAY INCLUDE ACTS THAT EMPLOY UNCONVENTIONAL OR HYBRID TACTICS, SUCH AS CYBERATTACKS, BIOLOGICAL THREATS, OR EVEN ACTS OF CIVIL DISOBEDIENCE IF DEEMED DISRUPTIVE ENOUGH.
- CONTEXTUAL AND CULTURAL VARIATIONS: RECOGNIZES THAT WHAT CONSTITUTES TERRORISM CAN VARY ACROSS DIFFERENT CULTURAL OR NATIONAL CONTEXTS, EMPHASIZING THE IMPORTANCE OF SITUATIONAL FACTORS.

IMPLICATIONS OF AN EXPANDED VIEW:

- IT ALLOWS POLICYMAKERS TO CLASSIFY A WIDER ARRAY OF ACTS AS TERRORISM, WHICH CAN BE USEFUL IN COUNTERTERRORISM STRATEGIES BUT MAY ALSO LEAD TO OVERREACH OR POLITICIZATION.
- IT EMPHASIZES THE IMPORTANCE OF UNDERSTANDING THE SOCIO-POLITICAL CONTEXT, ACKNOWLEDGING THAT ACTS OF VIOLENCE MAY SOMETIMES BE INTERPRETED DIFFERENTLY DEPENDING ON PERSPECTIVE.

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## MAJOR DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THE NARROW AND EXPANDED DEFINITIONS

UNDERSTANDING THE CORE DISTINCTIONS REQUIRES ANALYZING VARIOUS DIMENSIONS:

### 1. SCOPE AND INCLUSIVENESS

- NARROW DEFINITION:
  - FOCUSES STRICTLY ON ACTS THAT MEET SPECIFIC LEGAL CRITERIA.
  - TYPICALLY EXCLUDES STATE-SPONSORED ACTS UNLESS EXPLICITLY STATED.
  - LIMITED TO VIOLENCE AGAINST CIVILIANS WITH POLITICAL MOTIVES.
- EXPANDED DEFINITION:

- ENCOMPASSES A WIDER ARRAY OF ACTS, INCLUDING:
- VIOLENCE AGAINST MILITARY OR ECONOMIC TARGETS.
- ACTS BY STATE ACTORS.
- CYBER TERRORISM, BIOLOGICAL TERRORISM, AND OTHER UNCONVENTIONAL FORMS.
- RECOGNIZES ACTS MOTIVATED BY A BROADER SET OF MOTIVES, INCLUDING ECONOMIC OR SOCIAL GRIEVANCES.

## 2. ACTOR PROFILES

- NARROW DEFINITION:
- PRIMARILY NON-STATE ACTORS, INSURGENT GROUPS, OR TERRORIST ORGANIZATIONS.
- EMPHASIZES CLANDESTINE OR COVERT GROUPS OPERATING OUTSIDE STATE AUTHORITY.
- EXPANDED DEFINITION:
- INCLUDES STATE ACTORS AND GOVERNMENT AGENCIES IF THEIR ACTIONS MEET THE CRITERIA.
- RECOGNIZES THAT TERRORISM CAN BE STATE-SPONSORED OR STATE-PERPETRATED.

## 3. LEGAL AND POLICY IMPLICATIONS

- NARROW DEFINITION:
- PROVIDES CLEAR LEGAL BOUNDARIES, MAKING PROSECUTION STRAIGHTFORWARD.
- FACILITATES INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION BASED ON SHARED CRITERIA.
- EXPANDED DEFINITION:
- OFFERS FLEXIBILITY BUT MAY LEAD TO AMBIGUITY.
- POTENTIALLY BROADENS THE SCOPE OF LAW ENFORCEMENT, BUT AT THE RISK OF POLITICIZATION OR ABUSE.

## 4. POLITICAL AND ETHICAL CONSIDERATIONS

- NARROW DEFINITION:
- LESS SUSCEPTIBLE TO SUBJECTIVE INTERPRETATIONS.
- EASIER TO RALLY INTERNATIONAL CONSENSUS.
- EXPANDED DEFINITION:
- OPENS DEBATES ABOUT WHAT CONSTITUTES LEGITIMATE RESISTANCE VERSUS TERRORISM.
- CAN BE USED SELECTIVELY FOR POLITICAL PURPOSES, LEADING TO ACCUSATIONS OF BIAS.

## 5. PRACTICAL APPLICATION AND ENFORCEMENT

- NARROW DEFINITION:
- EASIER TO IMPLEMENT IN COURTS.
- FOCUSES ON CLEAR-CUT CASES.
- EXPANDED DEFINITION:
- ALLOWS AUTHORITIES TO ADDRESS A BROADER SPECTRUM OF THREATS.
- MAY COMPLICATE LEGAL PROCEEDINGS AND DEFINITIONS.

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# WHY DO THESE DIFFERENCES MATTER? THE IMPLICATIONS

UNDERSTANDING WHY THE DISTINCTIONS BETWEEN NARROW AND EXPANDED DEFINITIONS MATTER IS ESSENTIAL FOR GRASPING THEIR PRACTICAL, LEGAL, AND ETHICAL IMPLICATIONS.

## LEGAL CLARITY VS. FLEXIBILITY

- NARROW DEFINITION:
  - ENSURES CLARITY AND CONSISTENCY IN LEGAL PROCEEDINGS.
  - FACILITATES INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION AS STANDARDS ALIGN ACROSS JURISDICTIONS.
- EXPANDED DEFINITION:
  - OFFERS FLEXIBILITY TO RESPOND TO EVOLVING THREATS.
  - MAY LEAD TO INCONSISTENT APPLICATION OR OVERREACH, POTENTIALLY INFRINGING ON CIVIL LIBERTIES.

## POLICY AND COUNTERTERRORISM STRATEGIES

- NARROW APPROACH:
  - FOCUSES RESOURCES ON KNOWN TERRORIST GROUPS AND SPECIFIC THREATS.
  - CAN RISK MISSING BROADER PATTERNS OF VIOLENCE OR STATE-SPONSORED ACTS.
- EXPANDED APPROACH:
  - ALLOWS FOR A MORE COMPREHENSIVE COUNTERTERRORISM RESPONSE.
  - RISKS CONFLATING DIFFERENT FORMS OF VIOLENCE, POSSIBLY DILUTING FOCUS.

## POLITICAL AND ETHICAL DEBATES

- NARROW DEFINITIONS:
  - TEND TO BE LESS POLITICALLY CHARGED BUT MAY OVERLOOK COMPLEX OR CONTROVERSIAL ACTS.
- EXPANDED DEFINITIONS:
  - CAN BE POLITICIZED, USED TO JUSTIFY AGGRESSIVE POLICIES OR SUPPRESSION OF DISSENT.

## IMPACT ON VICTIMS AND SOCIETIES

- A NARROW DEFINITION MAY LIMIT RECOGNITION OF CERTAIN ACTS AS TERRORISM, AFFECTING VICTIM SUPPORT AND SOCIETAL ACKNOWLEDGMENT.
- AN EXPANDED DEFINITION CAN LEAD TO BROADER SOCIETAL RECOGNITION BUT MAY ALSO STIGMATIZE CERTAIN GROUPS OR MOVEMENTS UNJUSTLY.

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## HISTORICAL AND CONTEMPORARY EXAMPLES

TO ILLUSTRATE THE DIFFERENCES, CONSIDER THE FOLLOWING CASES:

- THE 9/11 ATTACKS:
- WIDELY CLASSIFIED AS TERRORISM UNDER BOTH DEFINITIONS DUE TO DELIBERATE TARGETING OF CIVILIANS, POLITICAL MOTIVES, AND UNLAWFUL MEANS.
- STATE-SPONSORED BOMBINGS OR MILITARY ACTIONS:
- UNDER A NARROW DEFINITION, THESE MIGHT NOT BE CLASSIFIED AS TERRORISM UNLESS THEY MEET SPECIFIC CRITERIA.
- UNDER AN EXPANDED VIEW, CERTAIN MILITARY ACTIONS OR COVERT OPERATIONS MIGHT BE LABELED AS TERRORISM, ESPECIALLY IF THEY INVOLVE DELIBERATE ATTACKS ON CIVILIAN POPULATIONS.
- CYBERATTACKS ON FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS:
- OFTEN CONSIDERED CYBERCRIME, BUT UNDER EXPANDED DEFINITIONS, THEY MAY BE CATEGORIZED AS CYBERTERRORISM IF INTENDED TO CAUSE SOCIETAL DISRUPTION.
- INSURGENCIES OR GUERRILLA WARFARE:
- SOME LEGAL FRAMEWORKS EXCLUDE THESE ACTS UNLESS THEY INVOLVE TARGETING CIVILIANS INTENTIONALLY.
- OTHERS MAY INTERPRET THEM AS TERRORISM IF THEY MEET BROADER CRITERIA.

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## CONCLUSION: THE RATIONALE BEHIND THE DEFINITIONS

THE DEBATE OVER NARROW VERSUS EXPANDED DEFINITIONS STEMS FROM FUNDAMENTAL QUESTIONS ABOUT SECURITY, JUSTICE, AND MORALITY.

- WHY DO WE NEED A NARROW DEFINITION?
- FOR CLARITY, CONSISTENCY, AND LEGAL PRECISION.
- TO ENSURE THAT ACTS ARE PROSECUTED BASED ON WELL-ESTABLISHED CRITERIA.
- TO PREVENT POLITICAL MISUSE OF THE TERM.
- WHY ADVOCATE FOR AN EXPANDED DEFINITION?
- TO ADAPT TO THE EVOLVING NATURE OF THREATS.
- TO RECOGNIZE THE COMPLEXITY OF MODERN CONFLICTS WHERE STATE AND NON-STATE ACTORS INTERTWINE.
- TO ENSURE COMPREHENSIVE COUNTERMEASURES AGAINST DIVERSE FORMS OF VIOLENCE.

IN ESSENCE, THE CHOICE BETWEEN NARROW AND EXPANDED DEFINITIONS REFLECTS A BALANCE: ON ONE SIDE, THE NEED FOR LEGAL CERTAINTY AND INTERNATIONAL CONSENSUS; ON THE OTHER, THE NECESSITY TO ADDRESS THE MULTIFACETED REALITIES OF VIOLENCE THAT THREATEN SOCIETIES TODAY.

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### FINAL THOUGHTS

THE DISTINCTIONS BETWEEN THE NARROW AND EXPANDED DEFINITIONS OF TERRORISM ARE MORE THAN ACADEMIC—THEY INFLUENCE LAWS, POLICIES, SOCIETAL PERCEPTIONS, AND ULTIMATELY, THE EFFECTIVENESS OF COUNTERTERRORISM EFFORTS. RECOGNIZING THE NUANCES HELPS IN CRAFTING BALANCED APPROACHES THAT RESPECT HUMAN RIGHTS WHILE ENSURING SECURITY. AS TERRORISM CONTINUES TO EVOLVE WITH TECHNOLOGICAL ADVANCEMENTS AND GEOPOLITICAL SHIFTS, SO TOO MUST OUR UNDERSTANDING AND DEFINITIONS—STRIVING FOR CLARITY, ADAPTABILITY, AND JUSTICE IN ADDRESSING ONE OF THE MOST PRESSING CHALLENGES OF OUR TIME.

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
