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IN THE MIDST OF A TENSE AND LIFE-THREATENING SITUATION, APRIL FOUND HERSELF CONFRONTED WITH A CHOICE THAT WOULD DETERMINE HER FATE. THE AIRSHIP SHE WAS ABOARD WAS SLOWLY SINKING INTO THE CLOUDS, AND TIME WAS RUNNING OUT. WITH HER HEART POUNDING AND HANDS TREMBLING, SHE HESITATED AT THE HATCH. - AIMING FOR A SAFE LANDING SPOT.

THE POWER OF COURAGE AND SELF-PRESERVATION

APRIL'S LEAP WAS MORE THAN A PHYSICAL ACT; IT WAS A TESTAMENT TO HER COURAGE. FACING HER FEARS ALLOWED HER TO TAKE CONTROL OF HER DESTINY, TRANSFORMING TERROR INTO STRENGTH.
