- USE FULL SENTENCES TO DEMONSTRATE LANGUAGE SKILLS.
- INCORPORATE WEATHER VOCABULARY NATURALLY INTO YOUR RESPONSES.
- PRACTICE VARIED RESPONSES TO AVOID SOUNDING REPETITIVE.
