SATIRE AND TONE

HUMOR AND IRONY

THROUGH HUMOR AND EXAGGERATION, THE CARTOON EVOKES EMOTIONAL RESPONSES:

THE EXAGGERATION OF PHYSICAL FEATURES AND THE INCLUSION OF SYMBOLIC ELEMENTS SERVE TO CARICATURE HIM AS A SELF-SERVING, POWERFUL FIGURE WHO EXPLOITS HIS POSITION FOR PERSONAL GAIN. THE CARTOON LIKELY EMPLOYS SATIRE TO CAST HIM IN A NEGATIVE LIGHT, EMPHASIZING THEMES OF MORAL DECAY, AUTHORITARIAN TENDENCIES, AND THE MISUSE OF POLITICAL INFLUENCE.

THIS PORTRAYAL ALIGNS WITH CRITICAL PERSPECTIVES ON LONG'S POLITICAL CAREER, HIGHLIGHTING CONCERNS ABOUT ABUSE OF POWER AND ETHICAL MISCONDUCT.
