WHILE THE BENEFITS ARE COMPELLING, MYERS ALSO ACKNOWLEDGES OBSTACLES:

FINANCIAL AND LOGISTICAL HURDLES

- HIGH CAPITAL INVESTMENT: BUILDING STATE-OF-THE-ART FACILITIES REQUIRES SUBSTANTIAL FUNDING.
- OPERATIONAL COSTS: MAINTAINING ADVANCED HABITATS AND RESEARCH PROGRAMS IS RESOURCE-INTENSIVE.
- LONG-TERM SUSTAINABILITY: ENSURING FINANCIAL VIABILITY OVER DECADES.

ETHICAL AND CULTURAL CONCERNS

- BALANCING CONSERVATION AND TOURISM: ENSURING THAT REVENUE-GENERATING ASPECTS DO NOT COMPROMISE ANIMAL WELFARE.
- CULTURAL SENSITIVITY: RESPECTING LOCAL CUSTOMS AND ENVIRONMENTS IN INTERNATIONAL PROJECTS.

SCIENTIFIC AND TECHNOLOGICAL LIMITATIONS

AS SOCIETY CONTINUES TO GRAPPLE WITH ENVIRONMENTAL CHALLENGES, EMBRACING THE PRINCIPLES LAID OUT IN MYERS'S ARTICLE COULD BE A SIGNIFICANT STEP TOWARD A MORE SUSTAINABLE AND COMPASSIONATE COEXISTENCE WITH OUR PLANET'S WILDLIFE.

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
