A HOME STUDY IS A COMPREHENSIVE ASSESSMENT OF PROSPECTIVE PARENTS' SUITABILITY TO ADOPT. IT INVOLVES INTERVIEWS, BACKGROUND CHECKS, AND HOME INSPECTIONS TO ENSURE A SAFE ENVIRONMENT FOR THE CHILD.

3. MATCHING WITH A CHILD

ONCE THE HOME STUDY IS APPROVED, THE AGENCY WORKS TO MATCH THE FAMILY WITH A CHILD. THIS STEP DEPENDS ON THE PREFERENCES OF THE ADOPTIVE PARENTS AND THE AVAILABILITY OF CHILDREN NEEDING HOMES.

4. LEGAL FINALIZATION

AFTER PLACEMENT, THERE IS A PERIOD OF SUPERVISION AND POST-PLACEMENT VISITS BEFORE THE LEGAL FINALIZATION OF ADOPTION IN COURT. THIS CONCLUDES WITH A COURT ORDER GRANTING PARENTAL RIGHTS.

FINANCIAL ASPECTS OF ADOPTION IN 2020

ADOPTION COSTS CAN BE SUBSTANTIAL, VARYING WIDELY DEPENDING ON THE TYPE AND CIRCUMSTANCES. FOR NILES AND MARSHA, THEIR TOTAL EXPENDITURE WAS \$15,500 IN 2020.

CONNECTING WITH LOCAL ADOPTION COMMUNITIES, SUPPORT GROUPS, AND COUNSELING SERVICES CAN PROVIDE ONGOING ASSISTANCE.

CHOOSING THE RIGHT ADOPTION PATH: PRIVATE, PUBLIC, OR INTERNATIONAL

BUDGETING AND SAVINGS

- START SAVING EARLY: OPEN A DEDICATED SAVINGS ACCOUNT FOR ADOPTION EXPENSES.
- EXPLORE GRANTS AND SUBSIDIES: SOME ORGANIZATIONS OFFER GRANTS OR ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS.
- CONSIDER EMPLOYER BENEFITS: SOME EMPLOYERS PROVIDE ADOPTION ASSISTANCE BENEFITS OR STIPENDS.

TAX STRATEGIES

- MAXIMIZE THE ADOPTION TAX CREDIT: KEEP DETAILED RECORDS TO CLAIM THE FULL BENEFIT.
- CONSULT A TAX PROFESSIONAL: TO NAVIGATE COMPLEX IRS RULES AND ENSURE COMPLIANCE.
- PLAN FOR FUTURE EXPENSES: SUCH AS ONGOING MEDICAL, EDUCATIONAL, OR EMOTIONAL SUPPORT.

- PERSONAL SAVINGS
- LOANS DESIGNED FOR ADOPTION COSTS

PREPARING FOR THE EMOTIONAL JOURNEY

- BUILD A SUPPORT NETWORK OF FRIENDS, FAMILY, AND PROFESSIONALS.
- ENGAGE IN COUNSELING OR SUPPORT GROUPS FOR ADOPTIVE FAMILIES.
- EDUCATE YOURSELF ABOUT ATTACHMENT, IDENTITY, AND DEVELOPMENTAL NEEDS.

PRACTICAL STEPS POST-ADOPTION

- COMPLETE POST-PLACEMENT VISITS AND REPORTS.
- REGISTER THE CHILD'S BIRTH OR OBTAIN A NEW BIRTH CERTIFICATE.
- CONSIDER LEGAL STEPS TO FINALIZE THE ADOPTION, SUCH AS A COURT HEARING.

FUTURE PLANNING AND RESPONSIBILITIES

ADOPTION IS A LIFELONG COMMITMENT. FINANCIAL PLANNING SHOULD CONSIDER:

- EDUCATIONAL EXPENSES: SAVING FOR COLLEGE OR EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES.
- HEALTHCARE NEEDS: ONGOING MEDICAL OR MENTAL HEALTH SUPPORT.
- LEGAL DOCUMENTATION: ENSURING ALL LEGAL DOCUMENTS ARE UP TO DATE.
