CONVERTING POUNDS TO OUNCES

THE FINAL STEP IS TO CONVERT THE WEIGHT OF THE HAY (OR THE TOTAL WEIGHT IF NEEDED) FROM POUNDS TO OUNCES.

CONVERSION FACTOR:

- 1 POUND = 16 OUNCES

CALCULATION FOR THE HAY:
