"PARA VER QUÉ HORA ES..." (TO SEE WHAT TIME IT IS...)

WHEN TO USE:

- WHEN THE EMPHASIS IS ON THE ACTION OF CHECKING OR VIEWING THE TIME.

TIPS FOR LEARNERS
