- **SMELL:** DETECT THE EARTHY SCENT OF SOIL AND DECAYING ORGANIC MATTER
- **TOUCH:** FEEL THE TEXTURE OF BARK, LEAVES, AND THE GROUND BENEATH YOUR FEET
- **TASTE:** (IF APPROPRIATE) SAMPLE EDIBLE WILD PLANTS OR FRUITS, WITH CAUTION

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT CAUSES THE DAPPLED SUNLIGHT EFFECT WHEN STANDING UNDER A TREE ON A SUNNY SUMMER DAY?

SCIENTIFIC EXPLANATION OF LIGHT AND SHADOW PLAY

HOW SUNLIGHT CREATES DAPPLED PATTERNS

- LEAF DENSITY AND SHAPE: DENSER FOLIAGE PRODUCES DARKER SHADOWS; LARGER OR MORE SPREAD-OUT LEAVES ALLOW MORE LIGHT TO FILTER THROUGH.
- BRANCH ARRANGEMENT: THE WAY BRANCHES ARE POSITIONED AFFECTS HOW LIGHT IS DIFFUSED.
- SUN'S POSITION: THE ANGLE OF THE SUN DETERMINES THE LENGTH AND ORIENTATION OF SHADOWS. WHEN OVERHEAD,

SHADOWS ARE SHORTER AND MORE DIRECTLY BENEATH BRANCHES.

- TIME OF DAY: AS THE SUN MOVES ACROSS THE SKY, SHADOW PATTERNS SHIFT ACCORDINGLY.

THE PHYSICS OF SHADOWS

SHADOWS ARE CREATED WHEN AN OBJECT BLOCKS LIGHT. THE SIZE AND SHARPNESS OF A SHADOW DEPEND ON:

- LIGHT SOURCE SIZE: THE SUN IS EFFECTIVELY A POINT SOURCE, BUT ITS APPARENT SIZE CAUSES SHADOWS TO HAVE FUZZY EDGES AT TIMES.
- DISTANCE: THE NEARER THE OBJECT (LEAVES, BRANCHES, GROUND), THE SHARPER THE SHADOW EDGES.
- SURFACE TEXTURE: UNEVEN GROUND CAN DISTORT SHADOW SHAPES.

THE ECOLOGICAL SIGNIFICANCE OF GROUND SHADOWS

THE PLAY OF LIGHT AND SHADOW UNDER A TREE IS MORE THAN JUST VISUALLY APPEALING; IT PLAYS A VITAL ROLE IN ECOSYSTEMS:
