IT ENSURES THE PRESERVATION OF PERSIAN MYTHOLOGY, HISTORY, AND RELIGIOUS SYMBOLISM WHILE FOSTERING ARTISTIC CONTINUITY. THESE THEMES SERVE AS THE VISUAL LANGUAGE THAT COMMUNICATES THE VALUES, MORALS, AND SPIRITUAL BELIEFS EMBEDDED WITHIN FERDOWSI'S EPIC. AS A RESULT, THE MANUSCRIPT BECOMES NOT ONLY A LITERARY TREASURE BUT ALSO A VISUAL LEGACY THAT BRIDGES PAST AND PRESENT, TRADITION AND INNOVATION. THE CAREFUL SELECTION AND DEPICTION OF MYTHIC KINGS, HEROIC DEEDS, DIVINE SYMBOLS, AND LEGENDARY CREATURES REAFFIRM THE MANUSCRIPT'S ROLE AS A MONUMENTAL TESTAMENT TO PERSIAN CULTURAL IDENTITY AND ARTISTIC ACHIEVEMENT.

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
