

A FUMIGATION COMPANY WAS HIRED TO ELIMINATE PESTS IN ONE OF TWO BUILDINGS IN A CONDOMINIUM COMPLEX THAT

INTRODUCTION: THE NEED FOR PROFESSIONAL PEST CONTROL IN CONDOMINIUM COMPLEXES

- ASSESSING PEST ACTIVITY LEVELS.

3. APPLICATION OF FUMIGATION
