SOME OF THE MOST NOTABLE INCLUDE:

- JANUARY: NEW YEAR'S DAY AND ORTHODOX CHRISTMAS.
- MAY: VICTORY DAY (MAY 9), COMMEMORATING THE VICTORY OVER NAZI GERMANY IN WWII.
- JUNE: RUSSIA DAY (JUNE 12), THE NATIONAL HOLIDAY CELEBRATING SOVEREIGNTY.
- NOVEMBER: UNITY DAY (NOVEMBER 4), PROMOTING NATIONAL UNITY.

HOWEVER, THE MOST UNIVERSALLY RECOGNIZED CELEBRATIONS ARE TIED TO THE GREGORIAN CALENDAR MONTHS, WITH JANUARY AND MAY OFTEN BEING PROMINENT.

MAJOR CELEBRATIONS AND THEIR ORIGINS

NEW YEAR'S DAY (JANUARY 1):

ADOPTED AS THE START OF THE NEW YEAR DURING SOVIET TIMES, IT REMAINS THE MOST WIDELY CELEBRATED HOLIDAY, MARKED BY FESTIVITIES, FIREWORKS, AND FAMILY GATHERINGS.

ORTHODOX CHRISTMAS (JANUARY 7):

DUE TO THE JULIAN CALENDAR USED BY THE RUSSIAN ORTHODOX CHURCH, CHRISTMAS FALLS ON JANUARY 7, DISTINGUISHED BY RELIGIOUS SERVICES AND TRADITIONAL CUSTOMS.

VICTORY DAY (MAY 9):

A PINNACLE OF RUSSIAN PATRIOTIC CELEBRATION, VICTORY DAY COMMEMORATES THE SURRENDER OF NAZI GERMANY IN 1945. IT FEATURES MILITARY PARADES, FIREWORKS, AND REMEMBRANCE CEREMONIES HONORING WWII VETERANS.

RUSSIA DAY (JUNE 12):

ESTABLISHED AS A NATIONAL HOLIDAY IN 1992, RUSSIA DAY CELEBRATES THE COUNTRY'S DECLARATION OF SOVEREIGNTY FROM THE SOVIET UNION IN 1990. IT IS MARKED BY OFFICIAL CEREMONIES, CONCERTS, AND FIREWORKS.

UNITY DAY (NOVEMBER 4):
