OVER TIME, THE CHEROKEE ADOPTED MANY EUROPEAN-AMERICAN CUSTOMS, INCLUDING FARMING TECHNIQUES, DRESS, AND GOVERNANCE STRUCTURES, LEADING TO A PERIOD OF RELATIVE STABILITY AND PROSPERITY IN THE EARLY 19TH CENTURY.

### THE TRAIL OF TEARS AND FORCED REMOVAL: A TURNING POINT

# THE INDIAN REMOVAL ACT AND ITS CONSEQUENCES

ONE OF THE MOST TRAGIC CHAPTERS IN CHEROKEE HISTORY IS THE FORCED REMOVAL KNOWN AS THE TRAIL OF TEARS. THE INDIAN REMOVAL ACT OF 1830, SIGNED INTO LAW BY PRESIDENT ANDREW JACKSON, AIMED TO RELOCATE NATIVE TRIBES FROM THEIR ANCESTRAL HOMELANDS TO TERRITORY WEST OF THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER.

FOR THE CHEROKEE NATION, THIS LED TO:

- FORCIBLE EVICTION FROM THEIR HOMELANDS BETWEEN 1838 AND 1839.
- THE DEATH OF APPROXIMATELY 4,000 CHEROKEE DURING THE ARDUOUS JOURNEY, DUE TO STARVATION, DISEASE, AND EXPOSURE.
- THE LOSS OF THEIR LAND, CULTURE, AND SOVEREIGNTY.

THIS EVENT REMAINS A SYMBOL OF SYSTEMIC INJUSTICE AND HAS DEEPLY INFLUENCED CHEROKEE IDENTITY AND ACTIVISM.

## RESILIENCE AND LEGAL BATTLES FOR SOVEREIGNTY

DESPITE THESE HARDSHIPS, THE CHEROKEE PEOPLE DEMONSTRATED RESILIENCE THROUGH:

- LEGAL EFFORTS SUCH AS *WORCESTER V. GEORGIA* (1832), ASSERTING THEIR SOVEREIGNTY.
- ESTABLISHMENT OF NEW COMMUNITIES IN INDIAN TERRITORY (PRESENT-DAY OKLAHOMA).
- REBUILDING THEIR GOVERNMENT, CULTURE, AND INSTITUTIONS IN EXILE.

### LAWSUITS AND LAND RIGHTS

### THE SIGNIFICANCE OF NATIVE PERSPECTIVES IN HISTORICAL NARRATIVES

ONE OF THE MOST PIVOTAL MOMENTS IN CHEROKEE HISTORY, AND A FOCAL POINT IN THE EXCERPT, IS THE FORCED REMOVAL OF THE CHEROKEE PEOPLE IN THE 1830s, KNOWN AS THE TRAIL OF TEARS. FROM A NATIVE PERSPECTIVE, THE TRAIL OF TEARS IS NOT JUST A HISTORICAL EVENT BUT A SYMBOL OF BETRAYAL, RESILIENCE, AND THE ONGOING STRUGGLE FOR JUSTICE.

### RESISTANCE AND LEGAL BATTLES

DESPITE FORCED REMOVAL, CHEROKEE LEADERS AND CITIZENS RESISTED EFFORTS TO ERASE THEIR NATION. NOTABLE EXAMPLES INCLUDE:

- POVERTY AND HEALTH DISPARITIES.
- LAND DISPUTES AND ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES.
- POLITICAL MARGINALIZATION AT LOCAL, STATE, AND FEDERAL LEVELS.

### BUILDING ALLIANCES AND PARTNERSHIPS

THE PATH FORWARD INVOLVES FORGING ALLIANCES WITH DIVERSE STAKEHOLDERS:

- COLLABORATING WITH ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS TO PRODUCE ACCURATE, RESPECTFUL HISTORIES.
- PARTNERING WITH ENVIRONMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS TO PROTECT TRIBAL LANDS.
- ENGAGING IN POLICY ADVOCACY TO UPHOLD SOVEREIGNTY AND RIGHTS.

### EMBRACING A NATIVE-CENTERED HISTORICAL NARRATIVE

ULTIMATELY, THE EXCERPT ADVOCATES FOR A PARADIGM THAT:

- RECOGNIZES NATIVE PEOPLES AS ACTIVE AGENTS OF HISTORY.
- VALUES INDIGENOUS KNOWLEDGE SYSTEMS AND WORLDVIEWS.
