- TERRAIN UTILIZATION: USING DENSE FORESTS AND NARROW PATHWAYS TO TRAP AND ENCIRCLE ADVANCING FORCES.
- KNOWLEDGE OF THE LAND: FRENCH AND NATIVE FORCES HAD SUPERIOR FAMILIARITY WITH THE TERRAIN, GIVING THEM A STRATEGIC ADVANTAGE.

THE COURSE OF THE BATTLE
