THE CLOCK, A SYMBOL OF TIME, SUGGESTS THAT A SIGNIFICANT MOMENT OR CHANGE IS IMMINENT. ITS RESTART AFTER YEARS OF SILENCE COULD FORESHADOW AN EVENT THAT ALTERS THE STORY'S COURSE OR SIGNIFIES A TURNING POINT.

CONCLUSION:

THIS DETAIL EXEMPLIFIES FORESHADOWING BECAUSE IT USES A SYMBOLIC OBJECT—THE CLOCK—TO SUBTLY PREPARE THE READER FOR A FORTHCOMING SHIFT OR REVELATION.
