- INCORRECT: *EVERY STUDENT SHOULD SUBMIT THEIR ASSIGNMENT.*

ADJECTIVE AND ADVERB PLACEMENT

POSITIONING ADJECTIVES AND ADVERBS CORRECTLY ENSURES CLARITY.

- PROPER: *THE QUICKLY RUNNING FOX WAS SEEN IN THE FOREST.*
- INCORRECT: *THE FOX WAS QUICKLY RUNNING IN THE FOREST.*

DON'T FORGET THE ESSENTIALS FOR COMPLETE SENTENCES

SUBJECT AND PREDICATE

EVERY COMPLETE SENTENCE MUST HAVE A SUBJECT (WHO OR WHAT THE SENTENCE IS ABOUT) AND A PREDICATE (WHAT IS SAID ABOUT THE SUBJECT).

PUNCTUATION AND CAPITALIZATION

PROPER PUNCTUATION MARKS THE END OF SENTENCES AND CLARIFIES MEANING. CAPITALIZE THE FIRST WORD OF EVERY SENTENCE.

CLARITY AND CONCISENESS

USE PRECISE WORDS AND AVOID UNNECESSARY FILLER TO MAKE YOUR SENTENCES CLEAR AND IMPACTFUL.

TIPS FOR USING WORDS EFFECTIVELY IN SENTENCE CONSTRUCTION

CHOOSE WORDS CAREFULLY

THE SIGNIFICANCE OF AGREEMENT IN SENTENCE CONSTRUCTION

- COLLECTIVE NOUN (SINGULAR): "THE TEAM IS WINNING."
- INDEFINITE PRONOUNS (SINGULAR/PLURAL): "EVERYONE IS HERE," BUT "FEW ARE AVAILABLE."

PRONOUN-ANTECEDENT AGREEMENT

PRONOUNS MUST AGREE IN NUMBER AND GENDER WITH THEIR ANTECEDENTS:

- CORRECT: "THE STUDENT LOST HIS BOOK."
- INCORRECT: "THE STUDENT LOST THEIR BOOK." (UNLESS INTENTIONALLY USING SINGULAR "THEY")

MODIFIERS AND AGREEMENT

MODIFIERS MUST AGREE WITH THE WORDS THEY MODIFY:

- CORRECT: "SHE WORE A RED DRESS."
- INCORRECT: "SHE WORE A RED DRESS," (IF "RED" IS INTENDED AS AN ADJECTIVE MODIFYING "DRESS" BUT COULD BE MISPLACED).

MAINTAINING AGREEMENT ENSURES CLARITY AND PREVENTS AMBIGUITY, MAKING SENTENCES MORE UNDERSTANDABLE AND PROFESSIONAL.

COMMON PITFALLS AND HOW TO AVOID THEM

DESPITE UNDERSTANDING GRAMMATICAL RULES, WRITERS OFTEN ENCOUNTER CHALLENGES THAT COMPROMISE SENTENCE AGREEMENT AND COMPLETENESS. RECOGNIZING THESE PITFALLS IS CRUCIAL FOR IMPROVEMENT.

- PLURAL: "THE COMMITTEE ARE ARGUING AMONG THEMSELVES."

CONSISTENCY IN CONTEXT IS KEY.

3. USING INCORRECT PRONOUNS

MISALIGNMENT BETWEEN PRONOUNS AND ANTECEDENTS CAN LEAD TO CONFUSION OR GRAMMATICAL ERRORS:

- INCORRECT: "EACH STUDENT SHOULD SUBMIT THEIR ASSIGNMENT."
- CORRECT: "EACH STUDENT SHOULD SUBMIT HIS OR HER ASSIGNMENT." (OR USE SINGULAR "THEY" IF PREFERRED).

4. FRAGMENTED OR RUN-ON SENTENCES

INCOMPLETE OR OVERLY LENGTHY SENTENCES HINDER CLARITY. USE PUNCTUATION AND CONJUNCTIONS TO MAINTAIN COHERENCE.

STRATEGIES AND BEST PRACTICES FOR ENSURING AGREEMENT AND COMPLETENESS

ACHIEVING GRAMMATICAL ACCURACY REQUIRES DELIBERATE EFFORT AND ADHERENCE TO BEST PRACTICES.

1. REVIEW AND REVISE
