AS A RESULT, CHAUCER'S CHARACTERS REMAIN COMPELLING AND RELEVANT, INVITING ONGOING ANALYSIS AND APPRECIATION FOR HIS NUANCED STORYTELLING CRAFT. WHETHER IN THE CONTEXT OF LITERARY HISTORY OR CULTURAL CRITIQUE, THE DETAILED CHARACTERIZATION IN THE CANTERBURY TALES CONTINUES TO EXEMPLIFY THE ENDURING IMPORTANCE OF SPECIFIC, WELL-CHOSEN DETAILS IN LITERATURE.
