AS A PART OF ORAL TRADITION, THIS STORY CONTINUES TO RESONATE, REMINDING US OF THE IMPORTANCE OF LISTENING, RESPECTING OUR ENVIRONMENT, AND REMAINING HUMBLE IN OUR PURSUITS. WHETHER VIEWED AS A TALE ABOUT ANIMAL TRANSFORMATION OR A METAPHOR FOR PERSONAL AND MORAL GROWTH, IT HOLDS A TIMELESS APPEAL THAT TRANSCENDS GENERATIONS AND CULTURAL BOUNDARIES.
