- AM (ANTE MERIDIEM) REFERS TO TIMES FROM MIDNIGHT TO NOON.
- PM (POST MERIDIEM) COVERS TIMES FROM NOON TO MIDNIGHT.

UNDERSTANDING WHETHER A TIME IS AM OR PM IS ESSENTIAL FOR ACCURATE CALCULATIONS, ESPECIALLY FOR TIMES AROUND NOON OR MIDNIGHT.

## STEP-BY-STEP CALCULATION OF SYDNEY'S FINISHING TIME

LET'S APPLY THESE BASIC PRINCIPLES TO THE GIVEN PROBLEM:

### STARTING TIME: 11:13 A.M.

SYDNEY BEGINS HER CLEANING SESSION AT 11:13 A.M.

## DURATION OF CLEANING: 45 MINUTES

SHE SPENDS A TOTAL OF 45 MINUTES CLEANING HER ROOM.

## ADDING THE DURATION TO THE STARTING TIME

NOW, WE WILL ADD 45 MINUTES TO 11:13 A.M.:

1. ADD MINUTES:  
-  $13 \text{ MINUTES} + 45 \text{ MINUTES} = 58 \text{ MINUTES}$
2. CHECK IF MINUTES EXCEED 60:  
- SINCE  $58 < 60$ , NO NEED TO CONVERT TO HOURS.
3. DETERMINE THE NEW HOUR:  
- THE HOUR REMAINS THE SAME BECAUSE WE HAVEN'T CROSSED INTO THE NEXT HOUR.
4. FINAL TIME:  
-  $11:13 \text{ A.M.} + 45 \text{ MINUTES} = 11:58 \text{ A.M.}$

THUS, SYDNEY FINISHES CLEANING HER ROOM AT 11:58 A.M.

## WHAT IF THE DURATION CROSSED AN HOUR BOUNDARY?

SOMETIMES, THE CLEANING TIME MIGHT BE LONGER, CROSSING INTO THE NEXT HOUR. LET'S EXPLORE AN EXAMPLE TO CLARIFY.

### EXAMPLE: CLEANING FOR 75 MINUTES STARTING AT 11:13 A.M.

1. ADD MINUTES:  
-  $13 \text{ MINUTES} + 75 \text{ MINUTES} = 88 \text{ MINUTES}$
2. CONVERT EXCESS MINUTES INTO HOURS:  
-  $88 \text{ MINUTES} = 1 \text{ HOUR AND } 28 \text{ MINUTES}$  (SINCE  $60 \text{ MINUTES} = 1 \text{ HOUR}$ ,  $88 - 60 = 28$ )
3. UPDATE THE HOUR:  
-  $11:13 \text{ A.M.} + 1 \text{ HOUR} = 12:13 \text{ P.M.}$
4. REMAINING MINUTES:  
- 28 MINUTES ADDED TO 12:13 P.M. RESULTS IN 12:41 P.M.

THEREFORE, IF SYDNEY CLEANED HER ROOM FOR 75 MINUTES STARTING AT 11:13 A.M., SHE WOULD FINISH AT 12:41 P.M.

## APPLYING TIME CALCULATIONS IN DAILY LIFE

UNDERSTANDING HOW TO CALCULATE FINISHING TIMES IS A VALUABLE SKILL THAT CAN BE APPLIED IN MANY CONTEXTS, SUCH AS:

- PLANNING DAILY SCHEDULES AND APPOINTMENTS

- SHE SPENDS 45 MINUTES CLEANING.
- ADDING 45 MINUTES TO HER START TIME RESULTS IN 11:58 A.M.
- THEREFORE, SYDNEY FINISHES CLEANING HER ROOM AT 11:58 A.M.

BY UNDERSTANDING BASIC TIME ADDITION PRINCIPLES AND PRACTICING THESE CALCULATIONS, YOU CAN CONFIDENTLY DETERMINE FINISHING TIMES FOR ANY SCHEDULED ACTIVITIES. ADD 45 MINUTES TO 11:13 A.M., WHICH RESULTS IN 11:58 A.M.

## Is Sydney still cleaning her room at 11:30 A.M.?

YES, BECAUSE SHE STARTED AT 11:13 A.M. AND IS CLEANING FOR 45 MINUTES, SO SHE IS STILL CLEANING AT 11:30 A.M.

## What is the importance of knowing the start time and duration in time calculations?

IT HELPS DETERMINE THE EXACT FINISHING TIME AND PLAN ACTIVITIES ACCORDINGLY.

## If Sydney had taken a 15-minute break during cleaning, what would be her actual finishing time?

HER ACTUAL FINISHING TIME WOULD BE 12:13 P.M., SINCE THE BREAK ADDS EXTRA TIME.

## What is the key concept in solving this problem?

THE KEY CONCEPT IS ADDING THE DURATION TO THE START TIME TO FIND THE FINISH TIME.

- START TIME: 11:13 A.M.
- DURATION: 45 MINUTES
- QUESTION: WHAT TIME DOES SYDNEY FINISH CLEANING?

THIS PROBLEM INVOLVES ADDING A DURATION TO A SPECIFIC START TIME. TO SOLVE IT EFFECTIVELY, WE NEED TO UNDERSTAND THE STRUCTURE OF THE 12-HOUR CLOCK, THE CONCEPT OF MINUTES AND HOURS, AND HOW TO HANDLE CROSSING OVER TO THE

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## BREAKING DOWN THE CALCULATION PROCESS

THE CALCULATION PROCESS CAN BE APPROACHED SYSTEMATICALLY BY FOCUSING ON ADDING THE MINUTES FIRST, THEN THE HOURS, AND FINALLY ADJUSTING FOR ANY OVERFLOW BEYOND THE HOUR OR DAY.

STEP 1: IDENTIFY THE STARTING POINT

SYDNEY BEGINS HER CLEANING AT 11:13 A.M.. THIS IS IN THE LATE MORNING, JUST PAST 11 O'CLOCK.

STEP 2: ADD THE MINUTES

SINCE THE DURATION IS 45 MINUTES, START BY ADDING THESE MINUTES TO THE INITIAL MINUTES:

- INITIAL MINUTES: 13
- MINUTES TO ADD: 45

CALCULATION:

$$13 + 45 = 58 \text{ MINUTES}$$

BECAUSE 58 MINUTES IS LESS THAN 60, THERE IS NO NEED TO CARRY OVER INTO THE NEXT HOUR AT THIS STAGE.

STEP 3: ADD THE HOURS

NEXT, CONSIDER WHETHER THE ADDITION OF MINUTES AFFECTS THE HOUR COUNT. SINCE THE TOTAL MINUTES (58) ARE STILL WITHIN THE SAME HOUR, THE HOUR REMAINS UNCHANGED AT 11.

RESULT SO FAR:

- TIME: 11:58 A.M.

STEP 4: CHECK FOR CROSSING INTO THE NEXT HOUR OR PERIOD

ADDING 45 MINUTES TO 11:13 A.M. RESULTS IN 11:58 A.M., WHICH IS STILL WITHIN THE SAME HOUR AND PERIOD OF THE DAY. THEREFORE, NO FURTHER ADJUSTMENTS ARE NECESSARY.

FINAL ANSWER:

- SYDNEY FINISHES CLEANING AT 11:58 A.M.

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## VISUALIZING THE TIME CALCULATION

SOMETIMES, THINKING VISUALLY OR USING A TIMELINE CAN HELP SOLIDIFY UNDERSTANDING:

- STARTING POINT: 11:13 A.M.

- ADD 45 MINUTES:
- FIRST, REACH THE NEXT HOUR:  $11:13 + 47 \text{ MINUTES} = 12:00 \text{ P.M.}$
- SINCE WE ONLY NEED TO ADD 45 MINUTES, WHICH IS 2 MINUTES LESS THAN 47, SUBTRACT 2 MINUTES FROM 12:00 P.M.

ALTERNATE APPROACH:

- $11:13 + 45 \text{ MINUTES}$ :
- TO REACH 12:00 P.M., ADD 47 MINUTES.
- SINCE 45 MINUTES IS 2 MINUTES LESS, THE END TIME IS 12:00 P.M. MINUS 2 MINUTES, WHICH IS 11:58 A.M.

THIS METHOD IS USEFUL FOR MENTAL MATH, PARTICULARLY WHEN THE SUM APPROACHES THE NEXT HOUR.

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## HANDLING EDGE CASES AND COMPLEX SITUATIONS

WHILE THIS PROBLEM IS STRAIGHTFORWARD, UNDERSTANDING HOW TO HANDLE MORE COMPLEX SCENARIOS IS KEY TO MASTERING TIME CALCULATIONS:

CROSSING OVER TO THE NEXT HOUR

SUPPOSE SYDNEY STARTED AT 11:45 A.M. AND CLEANED FOR 45 MINUTES:

- $11:45 + 45 \text{ MINUTES}$ :
- ADD 15 MINUTES TO REACH 12:00 P.M.
- REMAINING 30 MINUTES EXTEND INTO THE NEXT HOUR.
- FINAL TIME: 12:15 P.M.

CROSSING OVER TO THE NEXT DAY

IF SYDNEY STARTED AT 11:30 P.M. AND CLEANED FOR 45 MINUTES:

- $11:30 \text{ P.M.} + 45 \text{ MINUTES}$ :
- ADD 30 MINUTES TO REACH 12:00 A.M. (MIDNIGHT).
- REMAINING 15 MINUTES INTO THE NEXT DAY.
- FINAL TIME: 12:15 A.M. (EARLY MORNING OF THE NEXT DAY).

UNDERSTANDING THESE EDGE CASES ENSURES READINESS FOR ANY TIME CALCULATION TASK.

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## PRACTICAL APPLICATIONS OF TIME CALCULATIONS
