## ECONOMIC TRANSFORMATION

THE NATIONALIZATION OF OIL AND LAND REFORMS SIGNIFICANTLY ALTERED MEXICO'S ECONOMIC LANDSCAPE, FOSTERING A SENSE OF ECONOMIC INDEPENDENCE AND NATIONAL PRIDE.

## SOCIAL AND CULTURAL CHANGES
