HIGH SOCIOLOGIST CONDUCTED WORK ON INTERSECTIONALITY AMONG WORKERS IN NAIL SALONS? A. CATHARINE MACKINNON

UNDERSTANDING THE DYNAMICS OF SOCIAL INEQUALITY AND OPPRESSION HAS BEEN A CENTRAL CONCERN IN SOCIOLOGY AND FEMINIST THEORY. AMONG THE INFLUENTIAL FIGURES WHO HAVE SIGNIFICANTLY CONTRIBUTED TO THIS DISCOURSE IS CATHARINE MACKINNON, A RENOWNED SOCIOLOGIST, LEGAL SCHOLAR, AND FEMINIST ACTIVIST. WHILE MACKINNON'S PRIMARY WORK CENTERS ON ISSUES OF GENDER, SEXUAL HARASSMENT, AND LAW, HER INSIGHTS ALSO EXTEND INTO UNDERSTANDING THE INTERSECTIONALITY EXPERIENCED BY WORKERS IN VARIOUS INDUSTRIES, INCLUDING NAIL SALONS. 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## WHO IS CATHARINE MACKINNON?

### BACKGROUND AND ACADEMIC CONTRIBUTIONS

CATHARINE MACKINNON IS A DISTINGUISHED AMERICAN SOCIOLOGIST, LEGAL SCHOLAR, AND FEMINIST ACTIVIST KNOWN FOR HER PIONEERING WORK IN GENDER EQUALITY AND SEXUAL HARASSMENT LAW. SHE EMERGED AS A LEADING VOICE IN THE FEMINIST MOVEMENT DURING THE LATE 20TH CENTURY, ADVOCATING FOR WOMEN'S RIGHTS THROUGH BOTH ACADEMIC RESEARCH AND LEGAL REFORM. HER SCHOLARSHIP OFTEN EMPHASIZES THE SYSTEMIC NATURE OF GENDER-BASED OPPRESSION AND THE WAYS IN WHICH LAW CAN BE USED AS A TOOL FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE.

MACKINNON'S SEMINAL WORKS INCLUDE "SEXUAL HARASSMENT OF WORKING WOMEN" (1979), WHICH WAS INSTRUMENTAL IN FRAMING SEXUAL HARASSMENT AS A FORM OF SEX DISCRIMINATION UNDER THE LAW, AND "TOWARD A FEMINIST THEORY OF THE STATE" (1989), WHICH ANALYZES HOW STATE INSTITUTIONS PERPETUATE GENDER INEQUALITIES. HER APPROACH COMBINES RIGOROUS LEGAL ANALYSIS WITH FEMINIST THEORY, MAKING HER A PIVOTAL FIGURE IN UNDERSTANDING THE INTERSECTIONS OF GENDER, LAW, AND SOCIAL JUSTICE.

### KEY THEORETICAL FRAMEWORKS

MACKINNON'S WORK IS CHARACTERIZED BY HER DEVELOPMENT OF THEORIES AROUND POWER, OPPRESSION, AND THE LAW. SHE ARGUES THAT GENDER INEQUALITY IS ROOTED IN SYSTEMIC POWER IMBALANCES THAT ARE REINFORCED THROUGH LEGAL AND SOCIAL INSTITUTIONS. HER EMPHASIS ON THE IMPORTANCE OF INTERSECTIONALITY—THOUGH THE TERM WAS POPULARIZED LATER BY KIMBERLÉ CRENshaw—ALIGNS WITH HER RECOGNITION THAT GENDER OPPRESSION IS OFTEN COMPOUNDED BY OTHER SOCIAL CATEGORIES SUCH AS RACE, CLASS, AND ETHNICITY.

HER ADVOCACY HIGHLIGHTS HOW LEGAL REFORMS MUST ADDRESS THESE INTERTWINED SOCIAL FACTORS TO ACHIEVE GENUINE EQUALITY. THIS PERSPECTIVE IS PARTICULARLY RELEVANT WHEN EXAMINING MARGINALIZED GROUPS, SUCH AS WORKERS IN NAIL SALONS, WHO OFTEN FACE MULTIPLE LAYERS OF DISCRIMINATION AND EXPLOITATION.

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# INTERSECTIONALITY AND NAIL SALON WORKERS

## UNDERSTANDING INTERSECTIONALITY IN THE CONTEXT OF NAIL SALON WORKERS

INTERSECTIONALITY IS A FRAMEWORK THAT ANALYZES HOW VARIOUS SOCIAL IDENTITIES—SUCH AS RACE, GENDER, CLASS, AND IMMIGRATION STATUS—INTERSECT TO CREATE UNIQUE EXPERIENCES OF OPPRESSION AND PRIVILEGE. NAIL SALON WORKERS, PREDOMINANTLY WOMEN OF COLOR, OFTEN EXPERIENCE A CONVERGENCE OF THESE SOCIAL IDENTITIES THAT EXPOSE THEM TO SYSTEMIC INEQUALITIES.

MANY NAIL SALON WORKERS ARE IMMIGRANTS, OFTEN FROM ASIAN COUNTRIES, WORKING IN LOW-WAGE, PHYSICALLY DEMANDING JOBS WITH LIMITED LEGAL PROTECTIONS. THEY FACE ISSUES SUCH AS:

- ECONOMIC EXPLOITATION: LOW WAGES, LACK OF BENEFITS, AND JOB INSECURITY.
- GENDERED DISCRIMINATION: EXPECTATIONS BASED ON GENDER ROLES THAT MARGINALIZE WOMEN.
- RACIAL AND ETHNIC DISCRIMINATION: STEREOTYPING AND MARGINALIZATION BASED ON ETHNICITY.
- IMMIGRATION-RELATED VULNERABILITIES: LIMITED LEGAL RIGHTS AND FEAR OF DEPORTATION.

THESE OVERLAPPING IDENTITIES CREATE A COMPLEX WEB OF VULNERABILITIES, MAKING IT DIFFICULT FOR WORKERS TO SEEK JUSTICE OR IMPROVE THEIR WORKING CONDITIONS.

## CATHARINE MACKINNON'S INSIGHTS ON INTERSECTIONALITY

ALTHOUGH MACKINNON DID NOT EXPLICITLY COIN THE TERM "INTERSECTIONALITY," HER WORK ON POWER DYNAMICS AND SYSTEMIC OPPRESSION PROVIDES A FOUNDATIONAL UNDERSTANDING RELEVANT TO INTERSECTIONAL ANALYSIS. HER EMPHASIS ON HOW LAW AND SOCIAL STRUCTURES SERVE TO REINFORCE DOMINANCE AND SUBJUGATION ALIGNS WITH THE REALITIES FACED BY NAIL SALON WORKERS.

MACKINNON'S APPROACH SUGGESTS THAT:

- LEGAL REFORMS MUST ADDRESS MULTIPLE AXES OF OPPRESSION SIMULTANEOUSLY. FOR NAIL SALON WORKERS, THIS MEANS RECOGNIZING HOW GENDER, ETHNICITY, AND IMMIGRATION STATUS COMBINE TO CREATE UNIQUE VULNERABILITIES.
- POWER IS MAINTAINED THROUGH SYSTEMIC STRUCTURES, INCLUDING LABOR LAWS, IMMIGRATION POLICIES, AND SOCIAL STEREOTYPES.
- EMPOWERING MARGINALIZED GROUPS REQUIRES CHALLENGING THESE SYSTEMIC STRUCTURES, NOT JUST INDIVIDUAL ACTS OF DISCRIMINATION.

HER WORK ENCOURAGES A COMPREHENSIVE VIEW THAT UNDERSTANDS THE EXPERIENCES OF NAIL SALON WORKERS AS SHAPED BY INTERSECTING SYSTEMS OF INEQUALITY.

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## APPLYING MACKINNON'S THEORIES TO NAIL SALON WORK CONDITIONS

### SYSTEMIC OPPRESSION AND WORKPLACE EXPLOITATION

MACKINNON'S ANALYSIS OF SYSTEMIC OPPRESSION IS VITAL IN UNDERSTANDING THE WORKING CONDITIONS OF NAIL SALON EMPLOYEES. MANY OF THESE WORKERS ARE SUBJECTED TO:

- WORKPLACE HARASSMENT AND ABUSE: POWER IMBALANCES OFTEN LEAD TO EXPLOITATION AND MISTREATMENT.

- LACK OF LEGAL PROTECTIONS: LIMITED ACCESS TO LABOR RIGHTS AND FEAR OF RETALIATION.
- HEALTH AND SAFETY RISKS: EXPOSURE TO CHEMICALS, INSUFFICIENT SAFETY MEASURES, AND ERGONOMIC ISSUES.
- LIMITED AGENCY: DUE TO IMMIGRATION STATUS OR LANGUAGE BARRIERS, WORKERS OFTEN HAVE LITTLE CAPACITY TO ADVOCATE FOR THEMSELVES.

THESE ISSUES ARE NOT ISOLATED BUT ARE INTERCONNECTED THROUGH SOCIETAL AND LEGAL SYSTEMS THAT UPHOLD INEQUALITY.

## INTERSECTIONAL CHALLENGES FACED BY WORKERS

APPLYING MACKINNON'S FRAMEWORK, THE INTERSECTIONAL CHALLENGES FACED BY NAIL SALON WORKERS INCLUDE:

- GENDERED VIOLENCE AND HARASSMENT: WOMEN, ESPECIALLY IN PATRIARCHAL SOCIETIES, ARE OFTEN VICTIMS OF SEXUAL HARASSMENT OR GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE.
- RACIAL AND ETHNIC DISCRIMINATION: STEREOTYPING BASED ON ETHNICITY CAN LEAD TO EXCLUSION AND UNEQUAL TREATMENT.
- ECONOMIC MARGINALIZATION: LOW WAGES AND JOB INSECURITY ARE COMPOUNDED FOR IMMIGRANT WOMEN WHO LACK LEGAL PROTECTIONS.
- IMMIGRATION VULNERABILITIES: FEAR OF DEPORTATION PREVENTS MANY FROM REPORTING ABUSES OR SEEKING LEGAL HELP.

THESE OVERLAPPING FACTORS CREATE A "MATRIX OF OPPRESSION," WHERE EACH FORM OF DISCRIMINATION INTENSIFIES THE OTHERS.

## LEGAL AND SOCIAL INTERVENTIONS INSPIRED BY MACKINNON

MACKINNON'S WORK UNDERSCORES THE NECESSITY OF SYSTEMIC CHANGE TO ADDRESS THESE ISSUES EFFECTIVELY. FOR NAIL SALON WORKERS, THIS COULD TRANSLATE INTO:

- STRENGTHENING LABOR PROTECTIONS: ENFORCING FAIR WAGES, SAFE WORKING CONDITIONS, AND ANTI-HARASSMENT POLICIES.
- LEGAL REFORMS ADDRESSING IMMIGRATION AND LABOR LAW: PROVIDING PATHWAYS FOR WORKERS TO REPORT ABUSES WITHOUT FEAR.
- COMMUNITY ORGANIZING AND ADVOCACY: EMPOWERING WORKERS THROUGH EDUCATION AND COLLECTIVE ACTION.
- CULTURAL SHIFTS: CHALLENGING STEREOTYPES AND SOCIETAL NORMS THAT PERPETUATE DISCRIMINATION.

HER ADVOCACY HIGHLIGHTS THAT ADDRESSING INDIVIDUAL GRIEVANCES IS INSUFFICIENT; INSTEAD, STRUCTURAL REFORMS ARE ESSENTIAL TO DISMANTLE THE SYSTEMIC INEQUALITIES.

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## IMPACT OF MACKINNON'S WORK ON MODERN SOCIOLOGY AND WORKER RIGHTS

### INFLUENCE ON FEMINIST AND INTERSECTIONAL THEORY

CATHARINE MACKINNON'S INSIGHTS HAVE PROFOUNDLY INFLUENCED FEMINIST LEGAL THEORY AND INTERSECTIONALITY STUDIES. HER EMPHASIS ON SYSTEMIC POWER AND LEGAL STRUCTURES HAS PROVIDED A FRAMEWORK FOR ANALYZING VARIOUS FORMS OF OPPRESSION, INCLUDING THOSE FACED BY MARGINALIZED WORKERS.

HER WORK HAS INSPIRED SCHOLARS AND ACTIVISTS TO CONSIDER THE MULTIFACETED NATURE OF INEQUALITY AND TO ADVOCATE FOR COMPREHENSIVE REFORMS.

# ADVOCACY FOR WORKER RIGHTS AND SOCIAL JUSTICE

MACKINNON'S THEORIES HAVE ALSO INFORMED CONTEMPORARY MOVEMENTS ADVOCATING FOR WORKERS' RIGHTS, ESPECIALLY AMONG VULNERABLE POPULATIONS LIKE NAIL SALON WORKERS. HER PERSPECTIVE ENCOURAGES A HOLISTIC APPROACH THAT CONSIDERS ALL INTERSECTING IDENTITIES AND SYSTEMIC BARRIERS.

ORGANIZATIONS WORKING TO IMPROVE CONDITIONS IN THE BEAUTY INDUSTRY OFTEN DRAW UPON HER IDEAS TO PUSH FOR LEGAL REFORMS, BETTER ENFORCEMENT, AND SOCIAL AWARENESS CAMPAIGNS.

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## CONCLUSION

CATHARINE MACKINNON'S GROUNDBREAKING WORK ON SYSTEMIC OPPRESSION, POWER, AND LAW PROVIDES INVALUABLE INSIGHTS INTO THE INTERSECTIONALITY FACED BY NAIL SALON WORKERS. HER EMPHASIS ON THE INTERCONNECTEDNESS OF SOCIAL CATEGORIES SUCH AS GENDER, RACE, AND CLASS UNDERSCORES THE IMPORTANCE OF COMPREHENSIVE SYSTEMIC REFORMS TO ADDRESS WORKPLACE EXPLOITATION AND INEQUALITY. WHILE SHE DID NOT EXPLICITLY FOCUS ON NAIL SALON LABOR, HER THEORIES REMAIN HIGHLY RELEVANT FOR UNDERSTANDING AND COMBATING THE MULTI-LAYERED OPPRESSION EXPERIENCED BY THESE WORKERS.

AS SOCIETY CONTINUES TO GRAPPLE WITH ISSUES OF LABOR RIGHTS, RACIAL JUSTICE, AND GENDER EQUALITY, MACKINNON'S WORK SERVES AS A GUIDING FRAMEWORK FOR SCHOLARS, ACTIVISTS, AND POLICYMAKERS COMMITTED TO FOSTERING EQUITABLE AND JUST WORKING ENVIRONMENTS FOR ALL, ESPECIALLY THOSE MOST MARGINALIZED.

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## INTERSECTIONALITY IN THE CONTEXT OF NAIL SALON WORKERS

### LEGAL AND SOCIAL FRAMEWORKS PERPETUATING EXPLOITATION

LEGAL PROTECTIONS FOR NAIL SALON WORKERS ARE OFTEN INADEQUATE, ESPECIALLY FOR UNDOCUMENTED WORKERS WHO FEAR DEPORTATION OR LEGAL REPRISALS. MACKINNON'S WORK ON SEXUAL HARASSMENT AND EMPLOYMENT DISCRIMINATION REVEALS HOW LEGAL SYSTEMS CAN FAIL TO RECOGNIZE OR ADDRESS THE NUANCED FORMS OF WORKPLACE ABUSE FACED BY MARGINALIZED GROUPS. HER CRITIQUE OF LEGAL STRUCTURES EMPHASIZES THAT:

- LAWS OFTEN REFLECT SOCIETAL BIASES, PRIVILEGING THE INTERESTS OF EMPLOYERS OVER WORKERS
- LEGAL REMEDIES MAY BE INACCESSIBLE OR INEFFECTIVE FOR VULNERABLE POPULATIONS
- CULTURAL NORMS CAN NORMALIZE OR DISMISS WORKPLACE EXPLOITATION

APPLYING MACKINNON'S INSIGHTS, ONE CAN SEE HOW SYSTEMIC NEGLECT AND LEGAL INVISIBILITY SERVE TO PERPETUATE THE EXPLOITATION OF NAIL SALON WORKERS, PARTICULARLY THOSE AT THE INTERSECTION OF MULTIPLE MARGINALIZED IDENTITIES.

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# KEY CONCEPTS FROM MACKINNON APPLIED TO NAIL SALON WORKERS

## POWER AND OPPRESSION

MACKINNON'S ANALYSIS CENTERS ON HOW POWER OPERATES WITHIN SOCIAL AND LEGAL INSTITUTIONS TO SUSTAIN INEQUALITY. IN THE NAIL SALON CONTEXT, THIS MANIFESTS AS:

- EMPLOYER DOMINANCE OVER WORKERS THROUGH ECONOMIC DEPENDENCY
- GENDERED EXPECTATIONS THAT WOMEN ACCEPT SUBSERVIENT ROLES
- RACIAL AND ETHNIC HIERARCHIES THAT DEVALUE IMMIGRANT LABOR
- CULTURAL NORMALIZATION OF EXPLOITATIVE LABOR PRACTICES

UNDERSTANDING THESE DYNAMICS THROUGH MACKINNON'S LENS HIGHLIGHTS THE IMPORTANCE OF CHALLENGING SYSTEMIC POWER RATHER THAN SOLELY FOCUSING ON INDIVIDUAL GRIEVANCES.

## STRUCTURAL VIOLENCE AND SYSTEMIC INJUSTICE

MACKINNON'S WORK EMPHASIZES THAT VIOLENCE AND INJUSTICE ARE EMBEDDED WITHIN SOCIETAL STRUCTURES. FOR NAIL SALON WORKERS, THIS INCLUDES:

- EXPOSURE TO TOXIC CHEMICALS AS A FORM OF ENVIRONMENTAL VIOLENCE
- WAGE THEFT AND LABOR VIOLATIONS AS ECONOMIC VIOLENCE
- DISCRIMINATORY IMMIGRATION POLICIES THAT RESTRICT WORKERS' RIGHTS

RECOGNIZING THESE ISSUES AS STRUCTURAL VIOLENCE UNDERSCORES THE NEED FOR SYSTEMIC REFORM TO PROTECT VULNERABLE WORKERS.

## LEGAL RECOGNITION OF INTERSECTIONAL DISCRIMINATION

MACKINNON ADVOCATES FOR LEGAL RECOGNITION OF DISCRIMINATION THAT OPERATES ALONG MULTIPLE AXES. APPLYING THIS TO NAIL SALON WORKERS SUGGESTS THAT:

- ANTI-DISCRIMINATION LAWS SHOULD CONSIDER INTERSECTING IDENTITIES
- LEGAL REMEDIES MUST ACCOUNT FOR COMPOUNDED VULNERABILITIES
- POLICY REFORMS SHOULD AIM TO DISMANTLE INTERSECTING OPPRESSIONS

THIS PERSPECTIVE CALLS FOR A HOLISTIC LEGAL APPROACH THAT ACKNOWLEDGES THE COMPLEXITY OF WORKERS' IDENTITIES.

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## PROS AND FEATURES OF MACKINNON'S APPROACH IN ADDRESSING WORKPLACE INTERSECTIONALITY

PROS:

- HOLISTIC FRAMEWORK: OFFERS A COMPREHENSIVE UNDERSTANDING OF HOW MULTIPLE FORMS OF OPPRESSION INTERSECT, RATHER THAN EXAMINING THEM IN ISOLATION.
- FOCUS ON POWER DYNAMICS: EMPHASIZES SYSTEMIC POWER RELATIONS, HIGHLIGHTING THE NEED FOR STRUCTURAL CHANGE.
- LEGAL ADVOCACY: SUPPORTS THE DEVELOPMENT OF LEGAL FRAMEWORKS THAT RECOGNIZE INTERSECTIONAL DISCRIMINATION.

- EMPOWERMENT OF MARGINALIZED WORKERS: ENCOURAGES ACTIVISM AND POLICY REFORMS TO ADDRESS SYSTEMIC INJUSTICES.

FEATURES:

- INTERDISCIPLINARY APPROACH COMBINING LEGAL THEORY, SOCIOLOGY, AND FEMINIST ACTIVISM.
- EMPHASIS ON SYSTEMIC CHANGE RATHER THAN INDIVIDUAL REMEDIES.
- RECOGNITION OF THE IMPORTANCE OF CULTURAL AND SOCIETAL NORMS IN PERPETUATING INEQUALITY.
- ADVOCACY FOR INTERSECTIONAL LEGAL RECOGNITION AND ENFORCEMENT.

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## CRITIQUES AND LIMITATIONS OF MACKINNON'S WORK IN THIS CONTEXT

WHILE MACKINNON'S CONTRIBUTIONS ARE INVALUABLE, SOME CRITIQUES AND LIMITATIONS SHOULD BE ACKNOWLEDGED:

- LEGAL FOCUS: HER EMPHASIS ON LEGAL REFORM MAY OVERLOOK GRASSROOTS AND COMMUNITY-BASED SOLUTIONS.
- LIMITED ENGAGEMENT WITH ECONOMIC STRUCTURES: WHILE ADDRESSING POWER, HER WORK MAY NOT FULLY EXPLORE THE ECONOMIC SYSTEMS UNDERPINNING LABOR EXPLOITATION.
- POTENTIAL OVERGENERALIZATION: APPLYING HER THEORIES ACROSS DIVERSE CONTEXTS MAY REQUIRE ADAPTATION TO SPECIFIC CULTURAL AND SOCIAL REALITIES.
- FOCUS ON GENDER: THOUGH INTERSECTIONALITY INVOLVES MULTIPLE AXES, HER PRIMARY FOCUS HAS BEEN ON GENDER, WHICH MAY LIMIT ANALYSIS OF OTHER IDENTITIES LIKE RACE AND CLASS.

DESPITE THESE CRITIQUES, HER FOUNDATIONAL INSIGHTS REMAIN HIGHLY RELEVANT FOR ANALYZING INTERSECTIONALITY AMONG NAIL SALON WORKERS.

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## IMPLICATIONS FOR POLICY AND ACTIVISM

APPLYING MACKINNON'S FRAMEWORK SUGGESTS SEVERAL AVENUES FOR MEANINGFUL CHANGE:

- LEGAL REFORMS: DEVELOP LAWS THAT EXPLICITLY RECOGNIZE INTERSECTIONAL DISCRIMINATION AND PROVIDE PROTECTIONS FOR IMMIGRANT AND LOW-WAGE WORKERS.
- WORKER ORGANIZING: SUPPORT COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AND UNIONIZATION EFFORTS THAT EMPOWER MARGINALIZED WORKERS.
- PUBLIC AWARENESS CAMPAIGNS: EDUCATE CONSUMERS AND POLICYMAKERS ABOUT THE LAYERED EXPLOITATION IN NAIL SALONS.
- HEALTH AND SAFETY REGULATIONS: ENFORCE STRICTER ENVIRONMENTAL AND OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH STANDARDS TO COMBAT CHEMICAL EXPOSURE.
- COMMUNITY SUPPORT SERVICES: OFFER LEGAL AID, LANGUAGE RESOURCES, AND HEALTH SERVICES TAILORED TO THE NEEDS OF IMMIGRANT WORKERS.

BY ADDRESSING SYSTEMIC POWER IMBALANCES AND RECOGNIZING THE INTERSECTIONAL REALITIES FACED BY THESE WORKERS, THESE STRATEGIES CAN FOSTER MORE EQUITABLE WORKING CONDITIONS.

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## CONCLUSION: THE SIGNIFICANCE OF MACKINNON'S WORK FOR UNDERSTANDING INTERSECTIONALITY IN NAIL SALON WORK

CATHARINE MACKINNON'S WORK PROVIDES A VITAL LENS THROUGH WHICH TO UNDERSTAND THE LAYERED COMPLEXITIES FACED BY NAIL SALON WORKERS AT THE INTERSECTION OF GENDER, RACE, AND CLASS. HER EMPHASIS ON SYSTEMIC POWER, LEGAL INEQUALITY, AND STRUCTURAL VIOLENCE OFFERS A COMPREHENSIVE FRAMEWORK FOR ANALYZING AND ADDRESSING THE EXPLOITATION ENDEMIC TO THIS INDUSTRY. WHILE HER PRIMARY FOCUS HAS BEEN ON GENDERED VIOLENCE AND DISCRIMINATION, THE PRINCIPLES SHE ARTICULATES ARE BROADLY APPLICABLE TO INTERSECTIONAL LABOR ISSUES, HIGHLIGHTING THE NECESSITY OF SYSTEMIC REFORM, LEGAL RECOGNITION, AND GRASSROOTS ACTIVISM.

AS EFFORTS CONTINUE TO IMPROVE CONDITIONS FOR MARGINALIZED WORKERS, INTEGRATING MACKINNON'S INSIGHTS CAN HELP CRAFT MORE EFFECTIVE, INTERSECTIONAL STRATEGIES THAT CHALLENGE THE ROOTS OF EXPLOITATION AND PROMOTE SOCIAL JUSTICE. RECOGNIZING AND DISMANTLING THE INTERSECTING SYSTEMS OF OPPRESSION ARE ESSENTIAL STEPS TOWARD CREATING A FAIRER, MORE EQUITABLE LABOR LANDSCAPE FOR NAIL SALON WORKERS AND BEYOND.
