

# IN THIS ILLUSTRATION, THE RINGS AROUND THE SUN REPRESENT A) ORBITS. B) SUN RAYS. C) RADIATION. D) DUST PARTICLES.

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UNDERSTANDING CELESTIAL IMAGERY REQUIRES CAREFUL OBSERVATION AND INTERPRETATION.
