UNDERSTANDING BRYCE CANYON NATIONAL PARK: AN OVERVIEW

LOCATION AND ACCESSIBILITY

BRYCE CANYON NATIONAL PARK IS SITUATED IN SOUTHERN UTAH, APPROXIMATELY 75 MILES NORTHEAST OF ZION NATIONAL PARK AND ABOUT 270 MILES SOUTH OF SALT LAKE CITY. THE PARK'S DISTINCTIVE GEOLOGICAL FORMATIONS—PRIMARILY HOODOOS, SPIRES, AND AMPHITHEATERS—ARE CARVED BY MILLIONS OF YEARS OF EROSION AND FROST-WEDGING, CREATING A SURREAL LANDSCAPE THAT APPEARS ALMOST ALIEN IN ITS BEAUTY.

THE GEOLOGY AND FORMATION OF BRYCE CANYON

THE UNIQUE GEOLOGICAL FEATURES

BRYCE CANYON IS RENOWNED FOR ITS HOODOOS—TALL, THIN SPIRES OF ROCK THAT RISE DRAMATICALLY FROM THE CANYON FLOOR. THESE FORMATIONS ARE PRIMARILY COMPOSED OF SEDIMENTARY ROCK LAYERS, INCLUDING LIMESTONE, SILTSTONE, AND MUDSTONE, THAT HAVE BEEN SCULPTED OVER MILLENNIA.

4. **RAIN AND WIND:** CONTINUOUS WEATHERING FURTHER SCULPTED THE FORMATIONS INTO THEIR CURRENT SHAPES.

SIGNIFICANCE OF THE ROCK LAYERS

THE VIBRANT COLORS AND STRATIFIED LAYERS TELL A STORY OF EARTH'S HISTORY, WITH EACH LAYER REPRESENTING A DIFFERENT GEOLOGICAL PERIOD. THE MOST PROMINENT COLORS INCLUDE REDS, ORANGES, AND WHITES, ADDING TO THE PARK'S VISUAL APPEAL.

- QUEEN'S GARDEN TRAIL: CONSIDERED ONE OF THE MOST SCENIC HIKE IN THE PARK, IT CONNECTS WITH THE NAVAJO LOOP AND OFFERS STUNNING VIEWS OF THE HOODOOS FROM BELOW.

3. BRYCE CANYON SCENIC DRIVE

A 38-MILE (61 KM) LOOP THAT GRANTS ACCESS TO MANY OF THE PARK'S MOST FAMOUS VIEWPOINTS AND TRAILHEADS. THE DRIVE IS ESPECIALLY SPECTACULAR DURING SUNRISE OR SUNSET, WHEN THE ROCK FORMATIONS GLOW WITH WARM HUES.

4. STARGAZING AND NIGHT SKY PROGRAMS

BRYCE CANYON IS A DESIGNATED INTERNATIONAL DARK SKY PARK, MAKING IT ONE OF THE BEST PLACES IN THE U.S. FOR STARGAZING. NIGHT SKY PROGRAMS AND GUIDED ASTRONOMY EVENTS ARE HELD REGULARLY, PROVIDING VISITORS WITH AN UNFORGETTABLE EXPERIENCE OF THE COSMOS.
