HIS ADVOCACY FOR THE PRESERVATION OF WILDERNESS AS A MORAL IMPERATIVE LAID THE GROUNDWORK FOR AMERICA'S NATIONAL PARKS MOVEMENT AND SET A STANDARD FOR ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP.

AS THE GLOBAL COMMUNITY FACES MOUNTING ECOLOGICAL CRISES, REVISITING MUIR'S WORDS REMINDS US OF THE IMPORTANCE OF SAFEGUARDING OUR NATURAL HERITAGE—NOT MERELY FOR ECONOMIC BENEFIT BUT FOR THE MORAL AND SPIRITUAL WELL-BEING OF FUTURE GENERATIONS. HIS CALL TO PROTECT THE WILD REMAINS AS URGENT AND INSPIRING TODAY AS IT WAS OVER A CENTURY AGO.
