CONVERSELY, WIDER LINES AT THE TOP THAT NARROW TOWARD THE BOTTOM CAN EVOKE THE NARROWING OF AN OBJECT IN FREE FALL, EMPHASIZING ACCELERATION AND MOMENTUM.

3. THE USE OF WHITE SPACE AND MARGINS

WHITE SPACE (EMPTY SPACE ON THE PAGE) PLAYS A CRUCIAL ROLE IN SHAPING THE VISUAL EFFECT. STRATEGICALLY PLACED WHITE SPACE AROUND THE TEXT CAN CREATE A SENSE OF EMPTINESS OR DISTANCE, ACCENTUATING THE IDEA OF SOMETHING LEAVING OR FALLING AWAY. THE PLACEMENT OF THE TEXT WITHIN THESE SPACES CAN SIMULATE THE ACCELERATION OR THE DISPERSAL OF AN OBJECT IN FREE FALL.

4. VARIATIONS IN FONT SIZE AND STYLE

ALTHOUGH MORE COMMON IN VISUAL POETRY, VARIATIONS IN FONT SIZE, BOLDNESS, OR ITALICS CAN ACCENTUATE THE SENSE OF MOVEMENT. FOR EXAMPLE, LARGER WORDS AT THE TOP THAT BECOME SMALLER AS THEY DESCEND CAN IMPLY DIMINISHING MOMENTUM OR THE DISPERSAL OF THE SUBJECT.

SYMBOLIC AND THEMATIC ASPECTS ENHANCING THE FALLING EFFECT

BEYOND THE TECHNICAL LAYOUT, THE THEMATIC CONTENT OF "WHITE-EYES" SIGNIFICANTLY CONTRIBUTES TO THE PERCEPTION OF A FALLING SHAPE.

1. THE IMAGERY OF WHITE EYES AND LOSS

THE TONE OF THE POEM—PERHAPS SOMBER, REFLECTIVE, OR MOURNFUL—FURTHER ENHANCES THE IDEA OF FALLING. THE DESCENT COULD SYMBOLIZE A FALL FROM GRACE, A DECLINE INTO DESPAIR, OR A SURRENDER TO GRAVITY AND MORTALITY. THE SHAPE ACTS AS A VISUAL METAPHOR FOR THESE EMOTIONAL STATES.

3. MOVEMENT FROM LIGHT TO DARKNESS OR FROM PRESENCE TO ABSENCE

THE VISUAL SHAPE CAN MIRROR AN EMOTIONAL JOURNEY, SUCH AS MOVING FROM CLARITY (AT THE TOP) TO OBSCURITY OR ABSENCE (AT THE BOTTOM). THIS TRANSITION ALIGNS WITH THE SHAPE OF SOMETHING FALLING, EMPHASIZING THE PROCESS OF LOSING STABILITY OR CLARITY.
