STORAGE AND HANDLING

- KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.
- DISCARD ANY UNUSED MEDICATION AFTER THE EXPIRATION DATE.

POTENTIAL SIDE EFFECTS AND HOW TO MANAGE THEM

COMMON SIDE EFFECTS

- GASTROINTESTINAL DISTURBANCES SUCH AS NAUSEA, VOMITING, DIARRHEA, OR ABDOMINAL PAIN.
- RASH OR ALLERGIC SKIN REACTIONS.
- YEAST INFECTIONS, ESPECIALLY ORAL OR VAGINAL THRUSH.

UNDERSTANDING DRUG INTERACTIONS AND PRECAUTIONS

DRUG INTERACTIONS

- AMOXICILLIN MAY INTERACT WITH OTHER ANTIBIOTICS, ORAL CONTRACEPTIVES, OR ANTICOAGULANTS.

PREVENTING FUTURE RESPIRATORY INFECTIONS

- PRACTICE GOOD HAND HYGIENE.

- AVOID SMOKING AND EXPOSURE TO IRRITANTS.
- KEEP VACCINATIONS UP TO DATE, INCLUDING INFLUENZA AND PNEUMOCOCCAL VACCINES.

DOSAGE AND FORMS

- LIQUID SUSPENSIONS

- KEEP MEDICATIONS OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

TEACHING STRATEGIES FOR PATIENTS STARTING AMOXICILLIN

EFFECTIVE PATIENT EDUCATION IS CRITICAL TO OPTIMIZE TREATMENT OUTCOMES AND MINIMIZE ADVERSE EFFECTS. HERE ARE KEY POINTS NURSES SHOULD COVER:

1. EXPLAIN THE PURPOSE AND EXPECTATIONS

- CLARIFY THAT AMOXICILLIN TARGETS SPECIFIC BACTERIA CAUSING THEIR RESPIRATORY INFECTION.

3. ADDRESS COMMON SIDE EFFECTS

- GASTROINTESTINAL DISTURBANCES: NAUSEA, VOMITING, DIARRHEA.
- ALLERGIC REACTIONS: RASH, ITCHING, SWELLING, DIFFICULTY BREATHING—SEEK IMMEDIATE MEDICAL HELP IF THESE OCCUR.
- OTHER EFFECTS: HEADACHE, DIZZINESS.

REASSURE PATIENTS THAT MILD GI DISCOMFORT CAN OFTEN BE MANAGED BY TAKING THE MEDICATION WITH FOOD, BUT IF SEVERE OR PERSISTENT, THEY SHOULD CONTACT THEIR PROVIDER.

4. HIGHLIGHT POTENTIAL DRUG INTERACTIONS AND PRECAUTIONS

- INFORM ABOUT POSSIBLE INTERACTIONS WITH OTHER MEDICATIONS SUCH AS ALLOPURINOL (MAY INCREASE RASH RISK) OR ORAL CONTRACEPTIVES (MAY REDUCE EFFECTIVENESS).
- ADVISE INFORMING ALL HEALTHCARE PROVIDERS ABOUT THE ANTIBIOTIC PRESCRIPTION.

5. PROMOTE ADHERENCE AND SAFETY

- STRESS THE IMPORTANCE OF COMPLETING THE ENTIRE COURSE, EVEN IF FEELING BETTER.
- WARN AGAINST SHARING MEDICATION WITH OTHERS.

- INSTRUCT CLIENTS TO SEEK IMMEDIATE CARE IF THEY EXPERIENCE SIGNS OF ALLERGIC REACTIONS, SEVERE DIARRHEA, OR OTHER UNEXPECTED EFFECTS.

SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS AND PATIENT EDUCATION

PATIENTS WITH ALLERGIES AND SENSITIVITIES

- VERIFY ALLERGY HISTORY TO PENICILLIN OR OTHER BETA-LACTAM ANTIBIOTICS.
- IF ALLERGIC, ALTERNATIVE TREATMENTS SHOULD BE CONSIDERED.

PATIENTS WITH RENAL IMPAIRMENT
