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INTRODUCTION

DESIGNING THE EXTENSION: THEMATIC EXPLORATION PROJECT

THIS SECTION DETAILS HOW EDUCATORS CAN GUIDE STUDENTS TO DEVELOP A COMPREHENSIVE PROJECT THAT ASSESSES THEIR UNDERSTANDING EFFECTIVELY.

- WRITTEN REPORT COMPLEMENTED BY VISUAL ELEMENTS

USING MULTIMEDIA FOSTERS TECHNOLOGICAL LITERACY AND MAKES PRESENTATIONS MORE ENGAGING.

STEP 3: CONTENT DEVELOPMENT

5. CREATIVE ELEMENTS SUCH AS SCENES REENACTED, CHARACTER INTERVIEWS, OR SYMBOLIC REPRESENTATIONS.

STEP 4: PRESENTATION AND REFLECTION

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

HOW CAN EXTENDING CHARLOTTE'S WEB HELP ASSESS STUDENTS' COMPREHENSION SKILLS?

WHAT IS AN EFFECTIVE WAY TO EXTEND CHARLOTTE'S WEB FOR ASSESSMENT PURPOSES THAT INVOLVES CRITICAL THINKING?

CONCEPTUAL FRAMEWORK FOR THE EXTENSION ACTIVITY

THE PROPOSED EXTENSION ACTIVITY CENTERS AROUND CREATING AN "ALTERNATIVE ENDING AND CHARACTER PERSPECTIVE PROJECT", DESIGNED TO EVALUATE UNDERSTANDING THROUGH MULTIPLE LENSES.

1. OBJECTIVES

- TO EVALUATE STUDENTS' ABILITY TO ANALYZE MOTIVATIONS AND CONSEQUENCES.

- TO DEVELOP PRESENTATION AND COLLABORATION SKILLS.

2. TARGET SKILLS

- CRITICAL ANALYSIS OF NARRATIVE ELEMENTS.
- CREATIVE STORYTELLING.

- COMMUNICATION AND PRESENTATION SKILLS.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF THE EXTENSION ACTIVITY

- ABILITY TO CONNECT EXTENSION WORK WITH ORIGINAL THEMES.

IMPLEMENTATION STRATEGIES

TO ENSURE THE ACTIVITY EFFECTIVELY ASSESSES UNDERSTANDING, EDUCATORS SHOULD CONSIDER THE FOLLOWING:

- CLEAR INSTRUCTIONS AND RUBRICS THAT SPECIFY EXPECTATIONS FOR EACH COMPONENT.
- MODEL EXAMPLES OF ALTERNATIVE ENDINGS AND CHARACTER PERSPECTIVES.
- GUIDED BRAINSTORMING SESSIONS TO HELP STUDENTS PLAN THEIR WORK.
- PEER REVIEW OPPORTUNITIES FOR FEEDBACK AND REFINEMENT.
- FLEXIBLE FORMATS TO ACCOMMODATE DIVERSE LEARNING STYLES AND RESOURCES.

EVALUATION AND FEEDBACK
