- DELAYS AND REWORK DUE TO LACK OF EXPERTISE
- COMPROMISED SAFETY AND QUALITY STANDARDS
- COST OVERRUNS FROM UNFORESEEN ISSUES
- LEGAL AND CONTRACTUAL DISPUTES
- DAMAGE TO REPUTATION AND FUTURE BUSINESS PROSPECTS

STRATEGIES FOR ENSURING THE BEST SUPPLIER SELECTION

PROS:

- REDUCES THE RISK OF PROJECT DELAYS DUE TO FINANCIAL ISSUES
- PROTECTS PROJECT OWNER FROM LIABILITIES

CONS:

- FINANCIAL INFORMATION CAN BE DIFFICULT TO VERIFY ACCURATELY
- OVERLY CONSERVATIVE SUPPLIERS MAY BE LESS COMPETITIVE

EVALUATING SUPPLIERS' EXPERIENCE

TRACK RECORD WITH SIMILAR PROJECTS

EXPERIENCE IN EXECUTING PROJECTS SIMILAR IN SCOPE, SIZE, AND COMPLEXITY IS PERHAPS THE MOST TELLING INDICATOR OF A SUPPLIER'S CAPABILITY.

FEATURES TO EXAMINE:

- PAST PROJECT PORTFOLIOS
- REFERENCES FROM PREVIOUS CLIENTS
- CASE STUDIES HIGHLIGHTING CHALLENGES AND SOLUTIONS

PROS:

- DEMONSTRATES PROVEN ABILITY TO DELIVER SIMILAR PROJECTS
- PROVIDES INSIGHT INTO THE SUPPLIER'S PROBLEM-SOLVING SKILLS

CONS:

- PAST SUCCESS DOES NOT GUARANTEE FUTURE PERFORMANCE
- LIMITED EXPERIENCE IN INNOVATIVE OR UNIQUE PROJECT REQUIREMENTS

PROJECT MANAGEMENT AND DELIVERY CAPABILITIES

- CLEAR PROJECT TIMELINES AND MILESTONES
- EFFECTIVE SUBCONTRACTOR MANAGEMENT

PROS:

- ENSURES TIMELY DELIVERY
- FACILITATES COORDINATION AMONG STAKEHOLDERS

CONS:

- OVERLY RIGID MANAGEMENT PLANS MAY HINDER ADAPTABILITY

FEATURES TO REVIEW:

- SAFETY RECORDS AND INCIDENT REPORTS
- ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT POLICIES
- CERTIFICATIONS SUCH AS ISO 14001

PROS:

- REDUCES HAZARDS AND LIABILITY
- ALIGNS WITH SUSTAINABLE PROJECT GOALS

CONS:

- SAFETY RECORDS MAY NOT BE COMPREHENSIVE
- ENVIRONMENTAL INITIATIVES MAY ADD TO COSTS
