- HE SEES ECONOMIC INTERESTS AS THE PRIMARY MOTIVATION BEHIND POLITICAL ACTIONS
- HE STRESSES THE IMPORTANCE OF ANALYZING CLASS STRUCTURES AND ECONOMIC POWER
- HE ADVOCATES FOR AN ECONOMIC DETERMINIST VIEW OF HISTORY

EXAMPLE: HAHN'S INTERPRETATION OF THE INDUSTRIAL REVOLUTION EMPHASIZES HOW ECONOMIC EXPANSION AND CLASS STRUGGLES SHAPED LEGISLATION, LABOR MOVEMENTS, AND SOCIAL STRUCTURES.

IMPLICATIONS OF THEIR DIVERGING VIEWS

IMPACT ON HISTORICAL ANALYSIS

THEIR FOCUS OFTEN LIES IN UNCOVERING THE UNDERLYING POWER STRUCTURES, ECONOMIC FORCES, AND CLASS STRUGGLES THAT DRIVE HISTORICAL CHANGE, SOMETIMES CHALLENGING MORE OPTIMISTIC NARRATIVES OF DEMOCRATIC PROGRESS.

THIS FUNDAMENTAL DIFFERENCE IN FOCUS—WILENTZ'S OPTIMISTIC VIEW OF DEMOCRATIC EVOLUTION VERSUS HAHN'S CRITICAL ANALYSIS OF ELITE POWER—CONSTITUTES A MAJOR INTERPRETIVE DIVERGENCE THAT INFLUENCES HOW EACH HISTORIAN ANALYZES KEY MOMENTS IN AMERICAN HISTORY.

HAHN'S PERSPECTIVE: CONFLICT, ELITE POWER, AND ECONOMIC INTERESTS

ALTERNATIVELY, HAHN'S APPROACH TENDS TO EMPHASIZE THE CONFLICTS BETWEEN DIFFERENT SOCIAL CLASSES, ECONOMIC INTERESTS, AND ELITES THAT HAVE DRIVEN AMERICAN POLITICAL DEVELOPMENTS. KEY FEATURES INCLUDE:

- FOCUS ON POWER STRUGGLES: HAHN SEES HISTORY AS CHARACTERIZED PRIMARILY BY CONFLICTS AMONG ELITES, ENTREPRENEURS, AND POLITICAL FACTIONS VYING FOR CONTROL.
- ECONOMIC FOUNDATIONS OF POLITICS: HIS ANALYSIS OFTEN CENTERS ON HOW ECONOMIC INTERESTS—SUCH AS THOSE OF THE LANDOWNING CLASSES, INDUSTRIALISTS, OR FINANCIERS—HAVE SHAPED POLICY AND POLITICAL OUTCOMES.

- CONS:
 - CAN UNDERPLAY THE AGENCY OF ORDINARY CITIZENS.
 - MIGHT PRESENT A MORE CYNICAL VIEW THAT RISKS NEGLECTING DEMOCRATIC ADVANCES.

IMPLICATIONS FOR INTERPRETATION OF MAJOR EVENTS

THE CONTRASTING PERSPECTIVES OF WILENTZ AND HAHN LEAD TO DIFFERENT READINGS OF SIGNIFICANT HISTORICAL EPISODES:

- JACKSONIAN DEMOCRACY:
 - WILENTZ VIEWS JACKSON'S ERA AS A DEMOCRATIZING FORCE, EXPANDING PARTICIPATION AND CHALLENGING ELITISM.
 - HAHN INTERPRETS JACKSONIAN POLITICS AS A CONTEST AMONG ELITE FACTIONS, WITH POPULISM MASKING UNDERLYING CLASS CONFLICTS.
- CIVIL RIGHTS MOVEMENTS:
 - WILENTZ OFTEN FRAMES CIVIL RIGHTS AS A CONTINUATION OF DEMOCRATIC IDEALS STRIVING TO FULFILL THE NATION'S FOUNDING PROMISES.
 - HAHN MIGHT ANALYZE CIVIL RIGHTS ACTIVISM AS A CHALLENGE TO ENTRENCHED ECONOMIC AND POLITICAL ELITES RESISTING CHANGE.

CONVERSELY, HAHN'S FOCUS ON CONFLICT AND ELITE INTERESTS REMINDS US THAT ECONOMIC POWER AND CLASS STRUGGLES ARE CENTRAL TO UNDERSTANDING POLITICAL CHANGE, OFTEN COMPLICATING IDEALISTIC NARRATIVES. BOTH APPROACHES OFFER VALUABLE INSIGHTS; WILENTZ'S PERSPECTIVE INSPIRES FAITH IN DEMOCRATIC POTENTIAL, WHILE HAHN'S CRITIQUE PROVIDES NECESSARY SKEPTICISM AND A DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF UNDERLYING POWER DYNAMICS.
